ACTION TAKEN ON THE SUGGESTIONS GIVEN IN THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The Principal informed the members about the action taken on the suggestions made during the previous meeting. It was recorded.

ITEM 1 RESULTS OF THE END OF SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS HELD DURING MAY AND NOVEMBER 2014

Dr. S. Logaswamy, Controller of Examinations presented the End of Semester Examinations results.

Dr. B. Sampathkumar observed that the pass percentage in certain courses (BBA CA, BSc Costume Design & Fashion, BSc IT, & BSc Physics) was below 50% and suggested the following ideas to improve the results in future.

After the Agenda taken for discussion the following suggestions were made by the experts:


Mr.M.P.Panneerselvam suggested to the Commerce Departments.
