KASC - Institution Innovation Council and Department of Commerce (PG) and Commerce with Professional Accounting jointly organized National Webinar on 'Entrepreneurial Pathfinder' from 16th November 2021 to 20th November 2021. The main objective of the webinar is to prepare the students to choose over their own entrepreneurial path and also to encourage entrepreneurial mindset of students. Five session was arranged through this webinar covering: (i) Entrepreneurship – An Overview; (ii) Entrepreneurial Opportunities; (iii) Dynamics and traits of Entrepreneurship; (iv) From Passion to Business: Passionate Entrepreneurship; (v) Governmental Schemes for Entrepreneurs.
