
In Semester IV, the core paper Data Mining and Warehousing and Multimedia Lab have been replaced by Software Testing and Software Testing Lab respectively.


Item 2 : To suggest a panel of Examiners, and Question Paper setters for Theory, Practicals and Project Viva-Voce.
