






Minutes of Board of Studies

Item 1:

Revising the Syllabi of Computer Science [CA] for the students to be admitted from 2020-2021.

In Semester I, the core paper Information Security has been replaced by an Elective Paper.

In Semester III, the Mini Project has been replaced by an Extra Departmental Course.

The papers Digital Image Processing, Robotics and Information Security have been added in the list of Elective Papers.

The paper Robotics has been replaced by Business Intelligence and Analytics in the list of Non Major Electives.

The Credit Points for Elective and Non-Major Elective Papers has been changed.

The Project viva-voce Marks have been changed from 200 to 100 and the Credit Points have been changed accordingly.

The Grand Total Marks have been changed from 2300 to 2200.
