  - ✓ Market Research
  - ✓ Competitive Analysis
  - ✓ Financial Projections
  - ✓ Marketing & Sales Strategy
  - ✓ Sustainability & Scalability

#### Mathematical Model

- ✓ Maximum of three participants
- ✓ Model should be based on Mathematical Applications
- ✓ Maximum of 4 minutes for presentation of the model.

#### RULES

##### Bin to Box

(Creating Wealth out of Waste)

- ✓ Maximum up to 4 participants per team
- ✓ Participants must create useful, artistic, or innovative items using waste materials
- ✓ Prohibited Materials: Medical waste, including syringes, refills, or any bio-hazardous items, are strictly NOT allowed
- ✓ Participants can use newspapers, plastic bottles, old CDs, fabric scraps, cardboard, tin cans, glass bottles, etc. can be used
- ✓ Some elements may be prepared in advance, but the final assembly must be done on site

#### Flameless Cooking

- ✓ Maximum 4 members per team
- ✓ No use of fire, gas stoves, or induction cooktops is allowed
- ✓ Participants must bring their own ingredients. Pre-cooked items are not allowed; everything must be prepared during the competition
- ✓ Participants can prepare snacks, salads, desserts, sandwiches, smoothies, or any other innovative dish that doesn't require fire
- ✓ Hygiene and cleanliness while cooking.

#### Note:

1. Registration will close by 10.30 am and only spot registration will be allowed.
2. Students can participate in any number of events
3. Students are advised to bring their own materials like mehendi cone, chart, wealth out of waste, flameless cooking,
4. Students have to be conscious about time management
5. Students can participate in any number of events
6. The Judges decision will be final
7. Winners will be honoured and Certificate will be provided to all the participants.

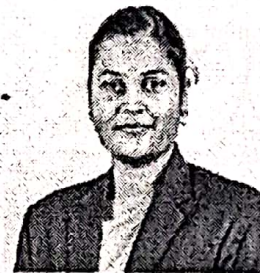
