

One day workshop on "Fisheries Enforcement Training" was given to the fish farmers in Chambath fisheries farm at Palakkad on 29.8.2016. This programme was funded by DBT star college scheme.

Dr.S.Binukumari organizing Secretary of this programme and 9 trained students from the Department of Zoology of our college visited this Chambath fisheries farm at Palakkad. During this training programme, many farmers from that area participated and gained many practical knowledge and techniques with regard to culturing of fishes and to increase the productivity.

Feed plays a vital role in fisheries. Growth and all activities of fish mainly depend on the food they consume. All the culturable species of fish mainly depend on a variety of natural feed and supplementary feeds required for intensive and semi-intensive culture systems. The commonly used plant feed ingredients are algal powder, ground nut oil cake, wheat flour and Tapioca powder. The animal feed ingredients are fish meal, Chicken intestine and prawn head meal.

The health and growth of the fish depend on the water quality. The quality of water is determined by physical factors, Chemical factors, biological factors and nutrients. The wastes in aquaculture farms can be categorized as residual food and fecal matter, metabolic byproduct residues of biocides and biostats, fertilizer derived wastes and wastes produced during moulting and collapsing algal blooms. The current approach to improving water quality in aquaculture is the application of microbes/enzymes to the ponds.

Making fish to spawn by artificial method is called induced breeding. Indian major carps are induced to spawn by the injection of pituitary extract, a process called Hypophysation. This principle involves the collection of pituitary gland, preparation of pituitary extract, selection of breeders, injection of pituitary extract, breeding and hatching. Based on thistechniques pure seeds can be obtained, seeds are available in large numbers, seeds can be obtained in all seasons and hybrid varieties can be produced.

The goal of the programme was making farmers to know the new trends in fish farming in order to increase the productivity. Farmers are facing a big problem of high production cost. We prefer some biological feeding methods and integrated fish farming to reduce the production cost. Another problem is the waste management in ponds. We suggested the bioremediation techniques for keeping pond clean. Mainly fish farmers participated in the programme and benefited.
