The Toda tribes of that village called Tharanadu mandh were very active and moved with friendly nature. Toda embroidery is one of the best tribal embroidery in south India, but it is yet to be developed in commercial scale. During the visit we also had a chance to learn their embroidery in Toda women centre.




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
