

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

The IQAC coordinator Dr.S.Krishnakumari, Associate Professor, Department of Biochemistry welcomed the gathering and Dr.M.Dhanam, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Physics introduced the chief guest Dr. Devaraj Nataraj, Associate Professor, Department of Physics, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore to the audience.

He elaborated the significance of silicon technology and how Graphene replaced silicon by its single layer arrangement of atoms and SP² hybridization. He highlighted that the award of noble prize to Andre Geim and Konstantin Novoselov was given in 2010 for ground breaking experiments regarding 2D material Graphene.

He explained the various preparation techniques and properties of Graphene and also discussed the direction and motion of mass less electrons in the Graphene lattice (Klein paradox). The lecture continued with explaining the current scenario in research on creating band gap in Graphene by reducing the size.

He mentioned China started research after thirty years of India started but now China is leading in research in terms of research publications, patents and industrial association etc. In addition resource also mention that research in India is narrower it should be wider.

He also said that curse of higher education is blindly following the British system of education. To improve the status of higher education in India, the resource person has discussed some points like in total GDP only 0.88% is spending for research and 2.7% for education this should be changed and more percentage should be given to improve the quality of higher education. Our teachers are strong in theory and less exposed in practical to avoid this practical should be given more weightage and interdisciplinary research should be supported. Moreover faculty and student exchange programmes in reputed national and international institutions will give more knowledge on recent trends in science and technology. Meanwhile government should give generous fund for same. He also highlighted that industrial collaboration for every faculty is mandatory to improve their skill.

On 15.02.2019, Dr. T. R. Ramprasad, Scientist, Department of Biochemistry, CFTRI, Mysore, Karnataka served as the Resource Person and delivered a lecture on the topic "Nutritional Biochemistry for Different Age Groups".

The programme was based on maintaining normal diet in today's life style and impact faced due to diabetics, coronary artery disease, Atherosclerosis, Obesity. Obesity is a disorder involving excessive body fat that increases the risk of health problems; prevention involves social changes, personal choices, diet, exercise, medication. Atherosclerosis is a disease involving hardening and narrowing of the arteries; causes are heart attack, stroke, and peripheral vascular disease. Diabetis is due to increase in blood sugar level; preventions mainly involve changes in life style and diet.

This was followed by next lecture by Dr S. Karthikeyan, Professor, Department of bioenergy, Tamil Nadu Agriculture University, Coimbatore, on the topic Biomass to Biofuel, in which he explained conservation of Biomass to Fuel, extraction of ethanol to produce ethanol blended petrol, sources, composition, and process of extraction of biofuels. Biomass Can be used to produce renewable electricity, thermal energy, transportation fuels (Biofuels). It is defined as living or recently dead organisms and any by-product of these organisms either plants or animals. Ethanol blending is a process of blending ethanol with petrol. Ethanol is mainly obtained from sugar industry which is a by-product of sugarcane molasses.
