**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RESULT PASSING BOARD**  
**END-OF-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS, DECEMBER 2020**

The all UG and PG candidates Result Passing Board meeting was held on 10/04/2021 at 10.30 a.m. in the Conference Hall. Dr.M.Lekeshmanaswamy, Principal and the Chairman of the Board presided over the meeting. Dr.N.Annalakshmi, Professor, Department of Psychology, Bharathiar University Nominee and the other members of the Result Passing Board were present.

**A brief account of December 2020 Examinations:**

The End-of-Semester Theory Examinations for II, III year UG & II year PG candidates were conducted **through online mode** between 21/12/2020 and 30/12/2020. The End-of-Semester Theory Examinations for I year UG candidates were conducted **through online mode** between 11/01/2021 and 21/01/2021. Final Year UG & PG candidates End-of-Semester Practical/Project Examinations were conducted between 15/02/2021 and 19/02/2021. The End-of-Semester Theory Examinations for I year PG & PG Diploma candidates were conducted **through offline mode** between 02/03/2021 and 06/03/2021. I & II Year UG & I PG candidates End-of-Semester Practical Examinations were conducted between 24/03/2021 and 31/03/2021.

A total of 4418 candidates had registered, out of which 4407 appeared for the Examinations. The Central Valuation for I, II, III year UG & II year PG were held on 05/02/2021, 06/02/2021, 13/02/2021 and 14/02/2021. The Central Valuation for I year PG & PG Diploma were held on 08/03/2021.

## Agenda for discussion:

### Item 1. To consider the award of moderation marks:

From the scrutiny of results of the Examinations of December 2020, it was found that for want of one, two or three marks, there were 32 failures in 30 papers in various UG & PG courses. According to the Autonomous Examination norms, a moderation of 3 marks could be awarded to a paper for a pass, subject to a total of 8 marks, for a maximum of 3 papers per candidate.

I, Dr.K.Murugesan, COE moved that moderation marks will be awarded to the failed candidates so as to enable them to acquire pass minimum and to declare them to have passed the Examinations.

***Result Passing Board unanimously resolved that the above move brought in by the COE regarding the award of moderation marks is approved.***

Among 18 UG and 14 PG passed out candidates appeared for arrears papers during the Examination of December 2020, 14 UG and 9




PG candidates cleared all the papers and qualified for the award Under Graduate and Post Graduate Degrees, respectively.



## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RESULT PASSING BOARD END-OF-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS, JUNE 2021

All UG, PG and Diploma candidates Result Passing Board meeting was held on 28/07/2021 at 3.00 pm. in the Seminar Hall. M.Lekeshmanaswamy, Principal and the Chairman of the Board presided over the meeting. Dr.N.Annalakshmi, Professor, Department of Psychology, Bharathiar University Nominee and the other members of the Result Passing Board were present.

### Brief account of June 2021 Examinations:

The End-of-Semester Practical/Project Examinations for UG, PG candidates were conducted **through offline mode** between 01/03/2021 and 31/03/2021. The Supplementary Theory examinations were conducted **through online mode** on 06/05/2021, 10/05/2021, 08/05/2021, 15/06/2021 and 16/06/2021. End-of-Semester Project Viva voce for Department of Biotechnology and Computer Science were conducted **through online mode** on 16/06/2021. The End-of-Semester Theory Examinations for UG, PG & Diploma candidates were conducted **through online mode** between 16/06/2021 and 05/07/2021.



