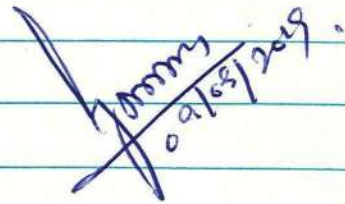
The minutes of the Board of Studies meeting in English under autonomous scheme was held on 09.03.2019 at 10:30 am in the Department of English.

Fiction - Ramayana - C. Rajagopalachari replaces 'The Cilappatikaram' in unit - IV
Stories from 'Greek Myths' by Robert Graves - Atlas and Prometheus, Pygmalion and Galatea, Perseus, Orpheus replace Aesop's Fables

Autobiographies - 'I Am Malala' part III (P.No 157-198) by Malala Yousafzai and 'The Story of My Experiments with Truth' (Excerpts from part I) by Mahatma Gandhi replace the short stories 'The Two Gentlemen of Verona' and 'How much land does a man need'.

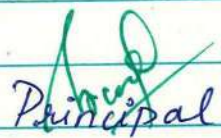
Item 14 To introduce Technical English as Major Elective in the place of English for Competitive Examinations.
