Item 2: To replace the Prescribed Plays in Unit I and Prescribed text in Unit II in Part II English II year.

Item 3: To revamp Allied Paper II Literary forms.

Item 4: To replace and re-arrange the Poems in Core paper V and VII. (Poetry I and II)

Item 5: To replace Prose piece and play in Core paper VIII Indian Writing In English.

Item 6: To replace Prose and Poem in Core Paper X American Literature.

Item 7: To add one more speech in each unit in Skill Based Subject - III Inspiring Speech.

Item 8: To replace the play in Unit core paper XIII Shakespeare II.

Item 9: To replace Novel in unit III with Prose in Core Paper XIV Indian Writing In English Translation.

Item 10: To introduce a Project Viva Voce in Semester VI.

Item 11: To introduce Six months certificate course in Journalism and Mass Media.

The following resolutions have been Passed Unanimously after the detailed discussions by the members of the Board:

Item 1	Replacing some lessons in Part - <u>II</u> English I year.	In Unit I and II of I year Part II English, two new Prose Pieces and one Poem is introduced in the place of existing lessons and two short stories included in

into 'Non-fiction Prose',
'Poetry' and 'Short stories'.
In Semester II of I year
Part II English five prose
lessons in Unit I are
introduced in the place
of existing lessons and
two short stories are
included in Unit III.

Item 2 Replacing the Prescribed Plays and texts in Part II English II year The Prescribed Play Shakespeare's 'Julius Caesar' is replaced with Shakespeare's 'The Merchant of Venice' in Semester III. In Semester IV Arthur Miller's 'All my sons' is replaced with George Bernard Shaw's 'Caesar and Cleopatra'. The textbook 'Communication Skills: A multi-skill course' Prescribed for Semester III and IV is replaced with 'Developing Communication Skills'.

Item 3 Revamping Allied Paper II Literary Forms. Allied Paper II Literary Forms for Semester II is revamped.

Item 4 Replacing and restructuring in Core paper V Poetry I and Core paper 7 Poetry II Core Paper 5 Poetry I for Semester III is restructured. The Poems in Unit I are replaced and the poem of the romantic age are included in Unit V in the place of existing Poems. Core Paper 7 Poetry II in Semester IV is restructured with two Poems Prescribed in each Unit the place of existing three.

Item 5 Replacing Prose and Play in Core paper 8 Indian Writing In English

In Core Paper 8 Indian Writing In English for Semester IV following changes are made:

In Unit II three of Abdul Kalam's Prose Pieces are replaced with Nirad Chaudhuri's 'Our Own behaviour'. In Unit III Tagore's Play 'chitra' is introduced in the place of Mahesh Dattani's 'Dance like a man'.

In Core Paper 10 American Literature in Semester V the

following changes are made: In Unit I Emerson's 'Hamatreya' is replaced with Edgar Allen Poe's 'The Raven'. In Unit II Emerson's 'Self-Reliance' is introduced, replacing the existing Prose Piece.

Item 7 Adding One more Speeches in each Unit in Inspiring Speeches.

In Semester V Skill Based Subject ~~III~~ Inspiring speeches One more speech in each Unit is included making a total of three lessons in each Unit.

Item 8 Replacing the play in Shakespeare II

In Semester VI Core Paper 13 Shakespeare 'Twelfth Night' is replaced with 'As you like it' in Unit II.

Item 9 Replacing Novel in Indian Literature in English Translation.

In Semester VI Core Paper XIV Indian Literature in English Translation the following changes are made: The Novel Kalki's 'Parthiban's Dream' is shifted from Unit III to Unit IV.

The Novel M.T. Vasudeva Nair's 'Kaalam' is replaced with Tagore's 'Reminiscences' chapter and II in Unit III.

Item 10 Introducing a project A Project followed by Viva Voce in Semester VI is introduced for III B English Literature students in Semester VI. In the place of Major Elective Paper Intensive study of An Author - Rabindranath Tagore.

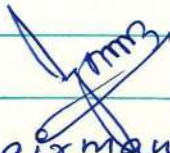
