The Department of Physics, Kongunadu Arts and Science College and SWELECT Energy systems Ltd jointly organized a state level solar and wind energy awareness workshop for farmers, funded by UGC-CPE scheme at Mr.Krishnamoothy's integrated form, Kanuvai village on 19.03.2016. Dr.R.Sathyamoorthy, Head of Physics delivered welcome address. Programme was inaugurated by Dr.C.A.Vasuki, Secretary and Director of KASC and delivered the inaugural address. She noted in the inaugural address that the scientific knowledge should be transferred from Lab to Land through like this programme. The programme was presided by Mr. Krishnamoorthy, Award winning Farmer, Kanuvai village followed by Thiru. M.Chinnaraj, Farmer, delivered keynote address.

Er.U.Arunachalam (SWELECT Energy systems Ltd) addressed the technical session about utilization of solar energy powered water pumping system and also live demonstrated using 6KW solar panel with 5Hp motor. Effective utilization of solar power and related Govt. subsidies were explored by Technicians from SWELECT and Bank Manager from Union Bank of India, Thudiyalur. Mr.Sridhar (A pioneer farmer in bio-waste management) shared his experience about utilization of bio-waste as bio-gas in Kitchen and Vehicles. Further he discussed about rain water management and solar energy utilization done by him. The participants were effectively interacted with the technical persons from the company and also with the farmers Mr. Krishnamoorthy and Mr. Sridhar. Mr. Ramasamy was interacted with the industrial personal and wish to install solar power to their farms and actively negotiated with all the farmers to bring down the cost of PV module. Then Er.U.Arunachalam has agreed to install the PV module at best price. In addition to that 10 farmers came forward to install the 1 KW solar panels and registered to their names with the industry started installation process.

More than 150 farmers get benefitted by this workshop. Solar powered gadgets like solar lantern, solar torch and solar powered air cooler are displayed and more than 10 farmers were purchased these solar powered gadgets. This awareness programme received a great attention and opened up a new scope in renewable energy management among the participants. The objective of the programme was fulfilled in all aspects. Finally, the programme ends with vote of thanks by Dr. M. Dhanam, Associate Professor of Physics.
