### Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2019-2020


### Introduction


The objective of the survey is to accumulate the feedback on the facilities the stakeholders has received during the time span they enrolled in the program. The survey will also infer the steps taken for the students' success in the program, and any suggestion for the improvement in on – off campus activities.

The SSS was developed by the Internal Quality Assessment Cell (IQAC) and it was taken up by the Final year students through Google form. (<u>https://forms.gle/YWweuJKnyD7tSyH4A</u>). The survey explored five main domains such as Curriculum, Teaching & Learning, Infrastructure, Skill development and other means of support. This report summarizes the findings in these areas.

### Curriculum

Curriculum Content and Strength of the syllabus is excellent and sufficient. The coverage of syllabus in the class is excellent with 80%. The fairness of evaluation system is about 90%. All the answer sheets are verified individually. 64.3 % of students says that the teachers regularly discuss about the assignments in the class. Institution encourages the students to participate in internships, students exchange programmes and field visits with 50% of votes.






The Institution facilitates the teaching and mentoring process systematically for improving social and emotional growth with a percentage of 69.2 %. Teacher educates the expected competencies, course outcomes and Programme Outcome clearly when new schemes adopted for teaching learning process.

All the mentors were regularly following the progress of the students. The students were satisfied with the student centric methods, experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies that enhanced the learning experiences to a great extent.


# Extra and Co-curricular activities



Eighty percent (80%) of the students reported that they were highly satisfied with the institution's encouragement in the participation of Co-curricular and extracurricular activities.


### **Placement Cell**


## Infrastructure


Students (70.3 %) felt that facilities available in campus, Laboratory equipments and Computers in laboratories that are provided by institution is more sufficient and are often accessible. 71.5 % of the students opines that the library has provided adequate resources and well organized.

More than half of the Students (75 %) observed that LCS, Smart class room system provides innovation in learning activity and they enjoy using it for learning purposes. 74.1 % of the students rates the facility of Language Laboratory in improving Communication skills is very good.
