Two Days Workshop on Traditional Painting on 28th & 29th August 2017 in F8


Report:

Application of CAD in Designing


Report:

The program was conducted on 2ndSeptember 2016 at 10.30 am to 4.00 pm in the Computer Lab VII.

Mrs.C.Sheeba, Assistant Professor, CDF Department, Welcomed the gathering and introduced the Chief Guest and also encouraged the students to actively participate and gain knowledge with updated ideas from the Designer.

In morning session, Mr.Suresh gave an introduction about the software - Adobe photoshopand explained how to use the tools to create a design and to incorporate it in the garment. 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

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
