


Sports Day Celebration

In 2009 bal pandi co-authored a book "Diary on the nesting behavior the nesting and behavior" of Indian birds along with naturalist "china sathan". That book contains 300 beautiful photographs. And he enlisted more than 300 different species of birds. After this publication he was offered to interact with a US based wild life conservator Murray. He was awarded with more than 5 awards including Green Honour award from **World wild life fund**. Due his innovative ideas of protecting birds, he is simply known as walking encyclopedia of birds. 
