
among the team members, a properly devised strategy and coordination among the team during implementation of the strategy, will help them to attain the task successfully.


The day was Felicitated by Dr. V. CHINNUSAMY, CEO, KASC, who spoke about the natural wealth of our locality.


The talks were very much inspiring for all the aspirant participants.
