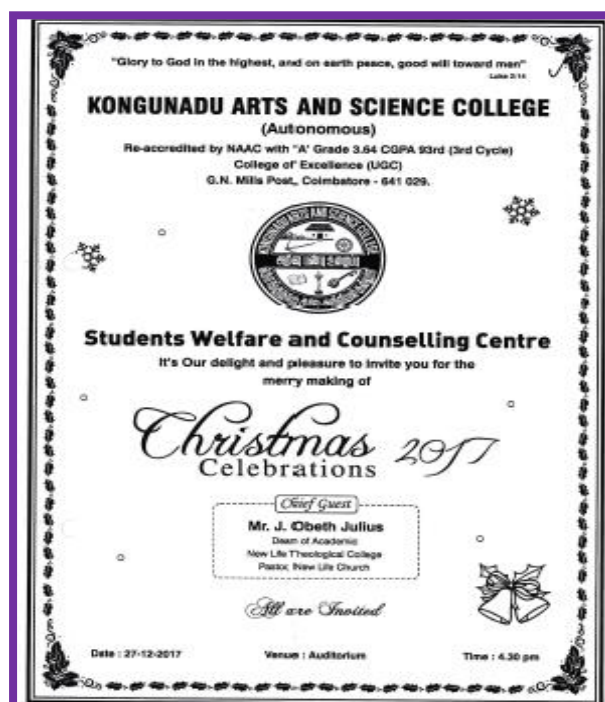

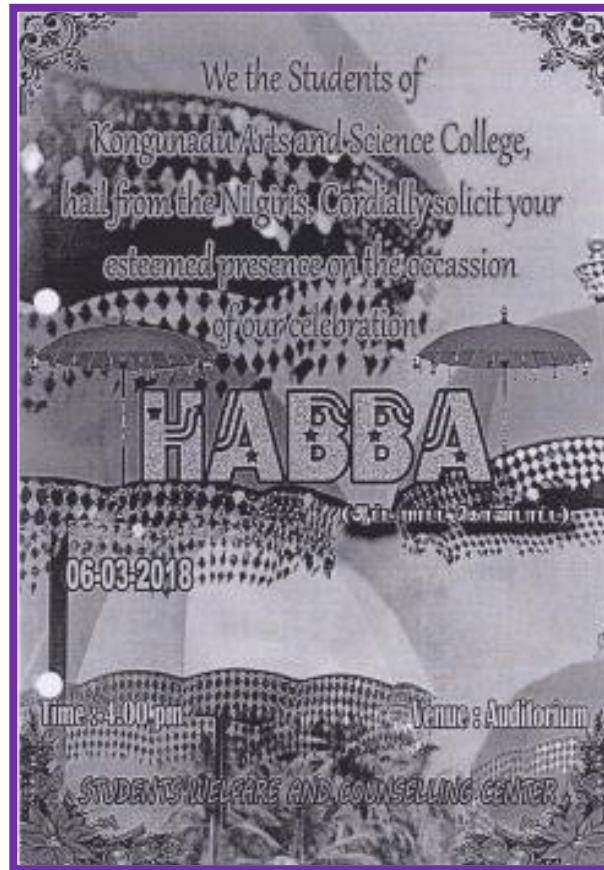

In connection with the 71st Independence Day celebrations , the PG Department of English (UA) conducted various literary competitions on 10.08.17.

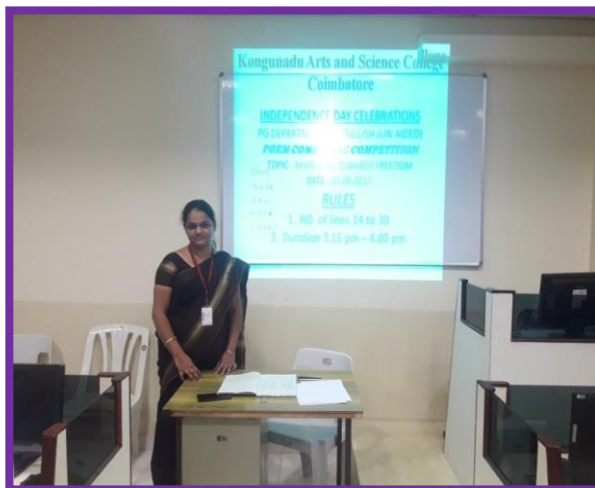
