

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RESULT PASSING BOARD
END-OF-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS, APRIL 2016

The Result Passing Board meeting was held on 06.05.2016 at 10.30 a.m. in the Auditorium. Dr.M.Lekeshmanaswamy, Principal i/c and the Chairman of the Board presided over the meeting. Dr.T.Devi, Professor & Head, Department of Computer Applications, Bharathiar University Nominee and the other members of the Result Passing Board were present.

A brief account on Examinations of April 2016:

End-of-Semester Practical/Project Examinations were conducted from 15-03-2016 to 29-03-2016. On-line End-of-Semester Examinations for the subjects Human Anatomy & Physiology and Health Assessment & Diagnosis were conducted on 15-04-2016. The Theory Examinations were conducted between 18-04-2016 and 30-04-2016. A total of 3577 candidates had registered, out of which 3573 appeared for the Examinations. The Central Valuation was held between 23-04-2016 and 03-05-2016.

Agenda for discussion:

Item 1. To consider the award of moderation marks:

From the scrutiny of results of the Examinations of April 2016, it was found that for want of one, two or three marks, there were 159 failures in 137 papers in various UG courses, 27 failures in 27 papers in various PG courses and 1 failure in 1 paper in PG Diploma course. According to the Autonomous Examination norms, a moderation of 3 marks could be awarded to a paper for a pass, subject to a total of 8 marks, for a maximum of 3 papers per candidate.

Further, 1 student, who failed in 1 paper by one mark in total, may be awarded one mark to pass a paper as per Autonomous examination norms.

I, Dr.S.Logaswamy, COE move that award of moderation of 3 marks to a paper for a pass, subject to a total of 8 marks for a maximum of 3 papers per candidate, to 159 candidates in 137 papers in various UG courses, 27 candidates in 27 papers in various PG courses, 1 candidate in 1 paper in PG Diploma course and one mark to 1 candidate in 1 paper be approved.

Result Passing Board resolve that the above move regarding the award of moderation marks is approved.

I, Dr.S.Logaswamy, COE move that after incorporating the resolution of agenda item 1, the results of all UG and PG courses be approved.

Item 1. Seven students were awarded the following punishment for the malpractices committed by them during the examinations of April 2016 as per the decision of the Disciplinary Action Committee.




















