**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RESULT PASSING BOARD**  
**END-OF-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS, APRIL 2019**

The Result Passing Board meeting was held on 07.05.2019 at 11.05 a.m. in the Conference Hall. Dr.V.Balasubramaniam, Principal and the Chairman of the Board presided over the meeting. Dr.N.Annalakshmi, Professor, Department of Psychology, Bharathiar University Nominee and the other members of the Result Passing Board were present.

**A brief account on Examinations of April 2019:**

End-of-Semester Practical/Project Examinations were conducted from 02-04-2019 to 13-04-2019. On-line End-of-Semester Examination for the subject Competitive Science II was conducted on 13-04-2019. The Theory Examinations were conducted between 15-04-2019 and 02-05-2019. A total of 4666 candidates had registered, out of which 4643 appeared for the Examinations. The Central Valuation was held on 24-04-2019, 29-04-2019, 30-04-2019, 02-05-2019 and 03-05-2019.

**Agenda for discussion:**

**Item 1. To consider the award of moderation marks:**

From the scrutiny of results of the Examinations of April 2019, it was found that for want of one, two or three marks, there were 199 failures in 151 papers in various UG courses, 38 failures in 34 papers in various PG courses and 3 failures in 1 paper in PG Diploma course. According to the Autonomous Examination norms, a moderation of 3 marks could be awarded to a paper for a pass, subject to a total of 8 marks, for a maximum of 3 papers per candidate.

Further, 2 students, who failed in 2 papers by one mark in total, may be awarded one mark to pass a paper as per Autonomous examination norms.

I, Dr.V.Balasubramaniam, Chief COE move that award of moderation of 3 marks to a paper for a pass, subject to a total of 8 marks for a maximum of 3 papers per candidate, to 199 candidates in 151 papers in various UG courses, 38 candidates in 34 papers in various PG courses, 3 failures in 1 paper in PG Diploma course and one mark to 2 candidates in 2 papers be approved.

**Result Passing Board resolve that the above move regarding the award of moderation marks is approved.**

**Item 2.** To consider the results of the End-of-Semester Autonomous Examinations, April 2019.
