## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RESULT PASSING BOARD, MAY 2018

The Result Passing Board meeting was held on 25.05.2018 at 11.00 a.m. in the Principal's Chamber. Dr.V.Balasubramaniam, Principal and the Chairman of the Board presided over the meeting. Dr.B.Vanitha, Registrar i/c, Professor & Head i/c, Department of Econometrics, Bharathiar University Nominee and the members of the Result Passing Board were present.

### A brief account of Revaluation and Special Supplementary Examinations:

The revaluation for the final year candidates who applied for revaluation was held on 19.05.2018. A total of 56 candidates, 18 candidates (12 papers) of PG and 38 candidates (27 papers) of UG applied for revaluation.

The Special Supplementary End-of-Semester Examinations for UG, & PG candidates having arrears in final Semester papers were conducted on 21-05-2018 and 22-05-2018. A total of 35 candidates had registered, out of which 33 appeared for the Examinations. The results are placed before the Result Passing Board.

#### Agenda for discussion:

# Item 1. To consider the award of moderation marks:

From the scrutiny of results of the Examinations of May 2018, it was found that for want of one, two or three marks, there was 1 failure in 1 paper in UG course. According to the Autonomous Examination Rules, a moderation of 1 mark could be awarded to a paper for a pass, subject to a total of 8 marks, for a maximum of 3 papers per candidate.

I, Dr.S.Logaswamy, COE move that award of moderation of 1 mark to a paper for a pass, subject to a total of 8 marks for a maximum of 3 papers per candidate, to 1 candidate in 1 paper in UG course be approved.

Result Passing Board resolve that the above move regarding the award of moderation marks is approved.

# Item 2. To consider and pass the results of Revaluation and Special Supplementary End-of-Semester Examinations held in May 2018:

I Dr.S.Logaswamy, COE move that the results of revaluation and UG & PG Candidates who appeared for the Special Supplementary End-of-Semester Examinations held in May 2018 be approved.

## Result Passing Board resolve that the results of all UG and PG courses are approved.

Item 3. Out of 56 candidates applied for 39 papers, 5 candidates got change of marks and 51 candidates got no change of marks in revaluation. Among 33 candidates appeared in the Special Supplementary Examinations, 28 candidates (5 PG and 23 UG) passed in the final semester arrear papers and qualified for the award of Post Graduate and Under Graduate Degrees in May 2018.
