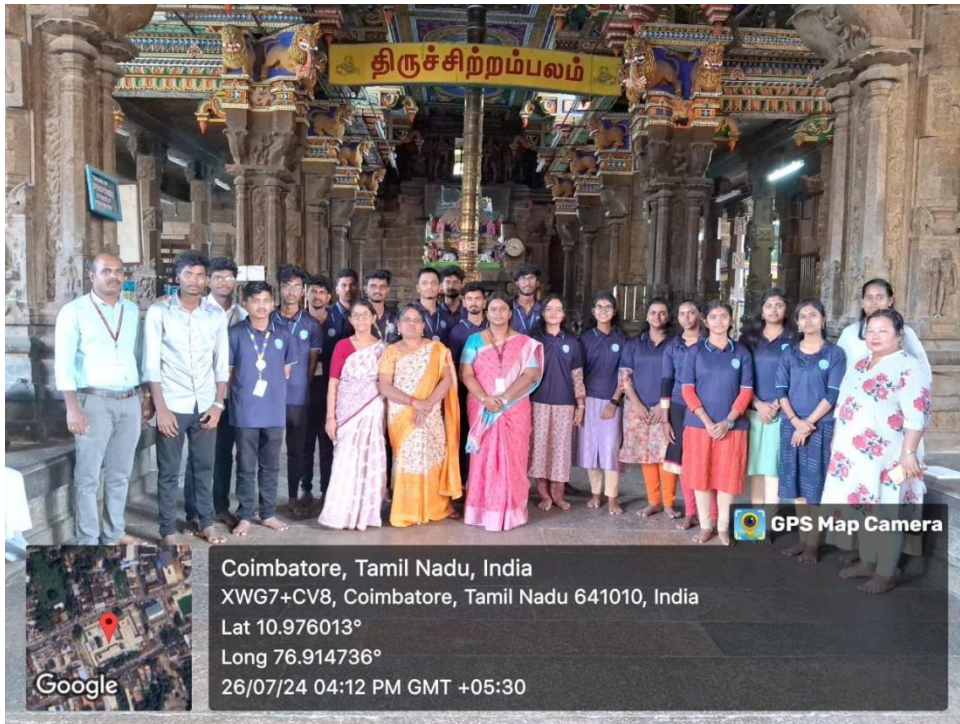





## 26/7/ 2024: Temple cleaning activity

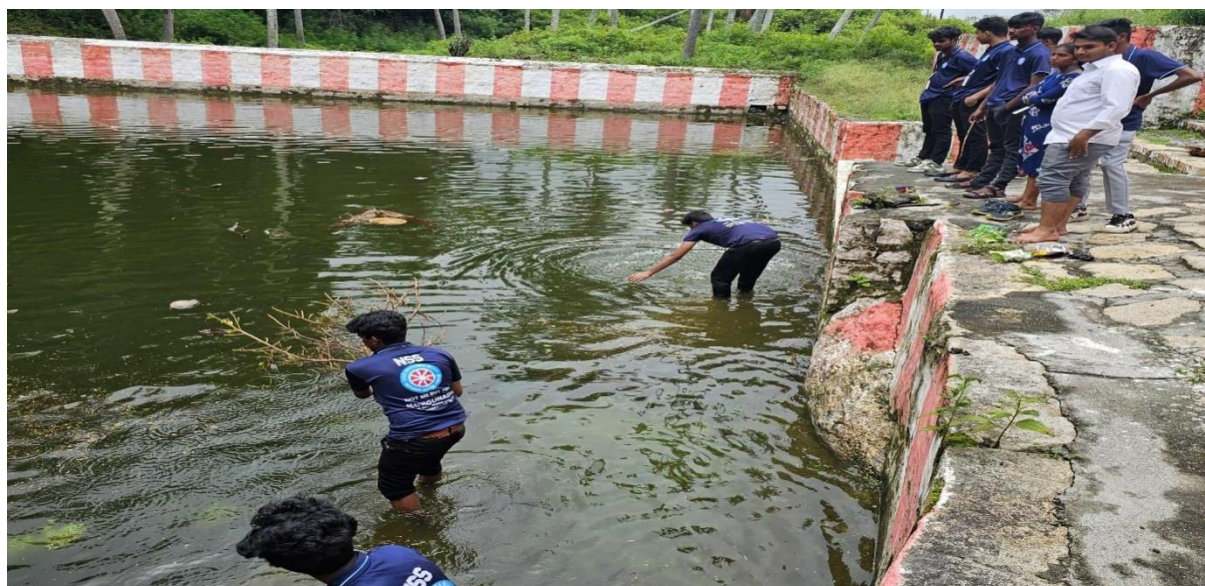


## **2.10.2024: Paalamalai temple cleaning camp**
