“IoT – Tools, Potential Applications and Challenges in Technology”

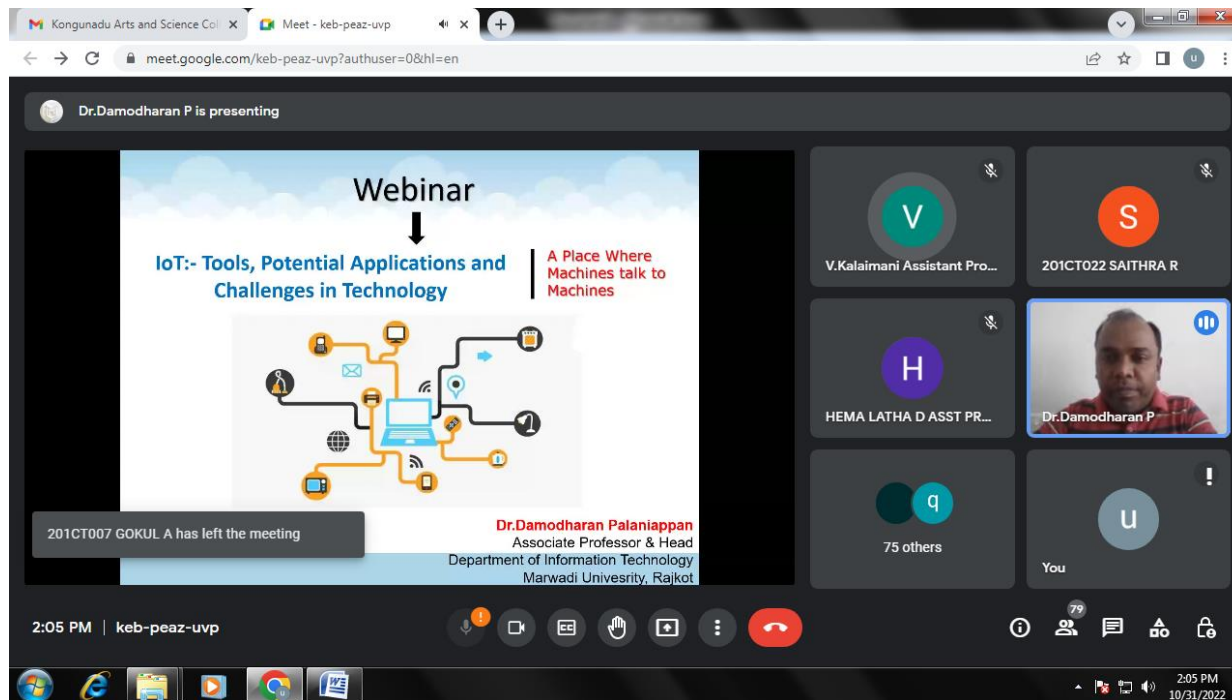
REPORT

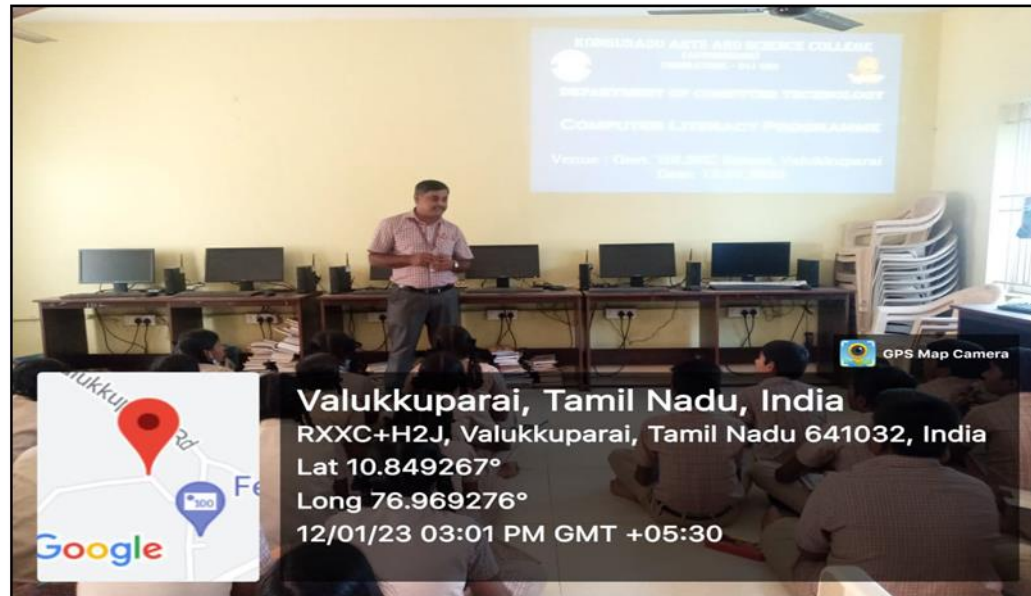

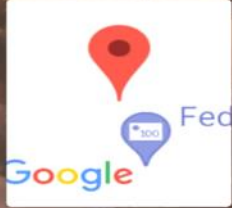
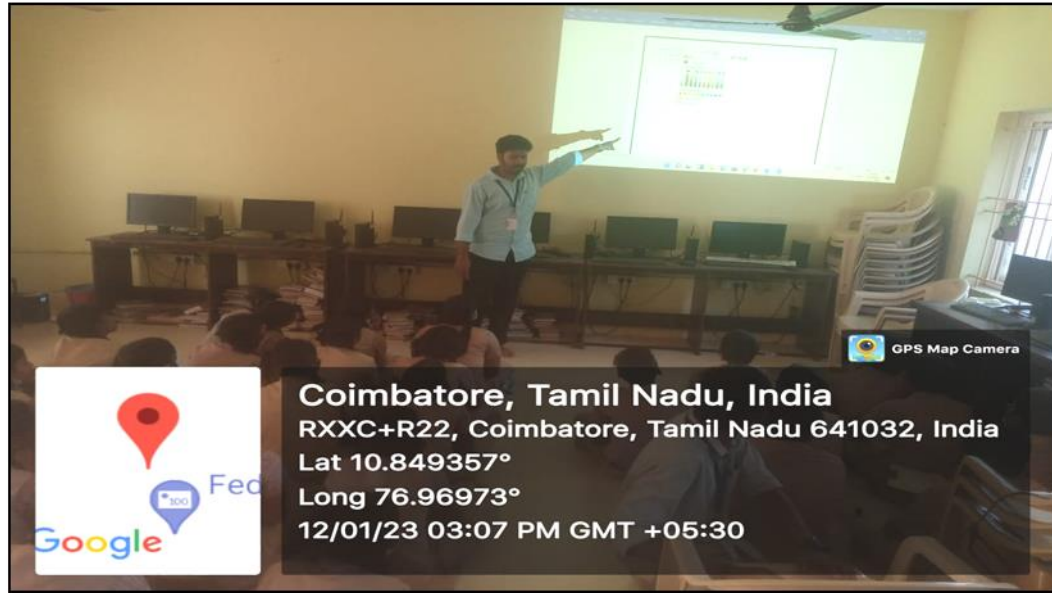
Computer Literacy Programme for Adapted Village School Students

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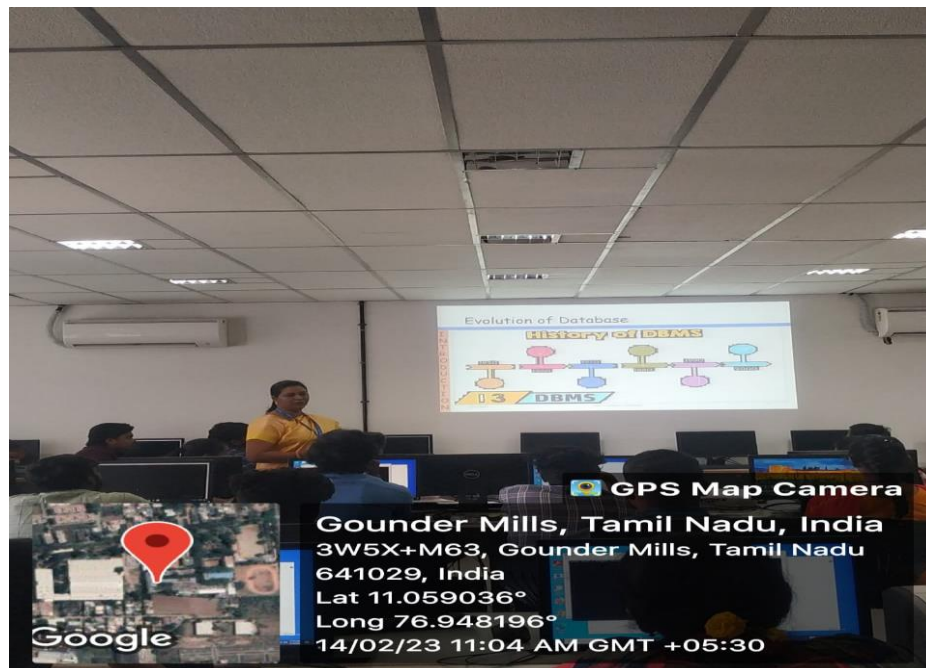

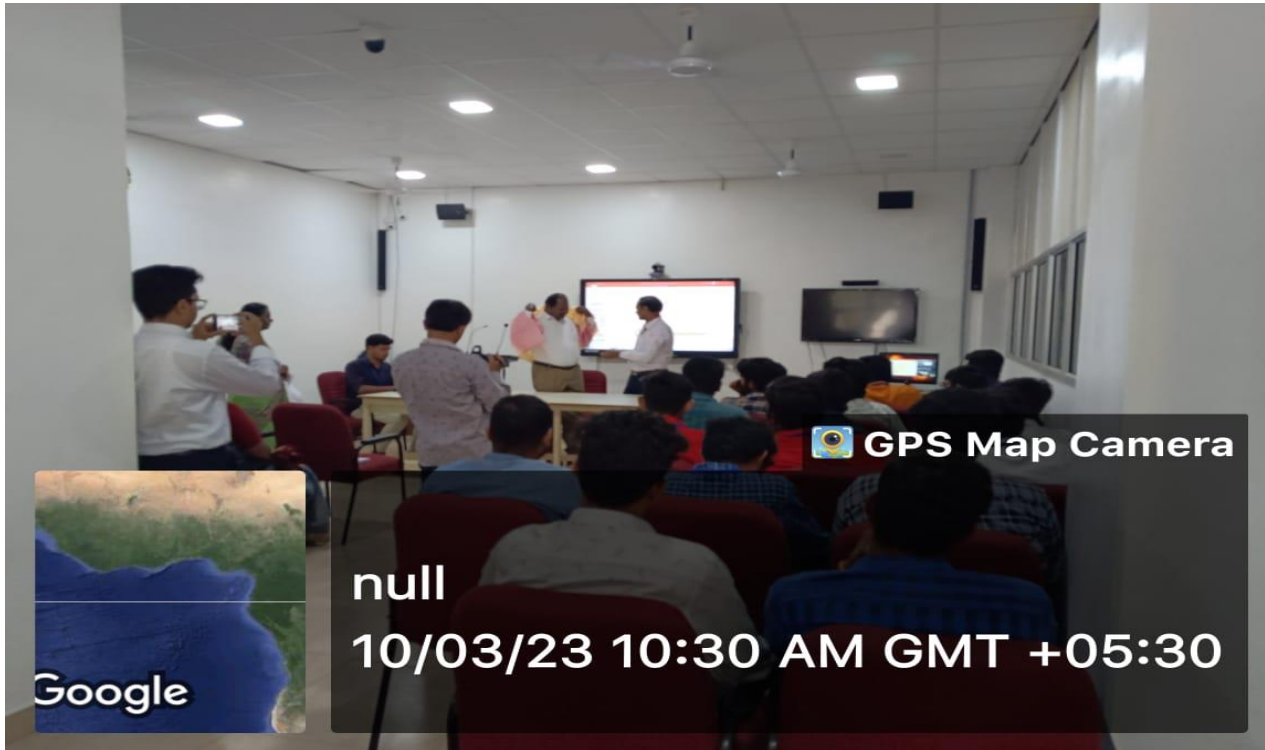


DIGITAL DISRUPTION ON INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS
