Report of Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum

Academic Year : 2019-2020

Name of the Department: English(Aided)

Students' Feedback on Curriculum: The feedback from the students was positive, with more than 80% of the I BA, 85% of II BA and more than 92% of III BA students approving the curriculum design and development and updation. On the whole it was seen that the I and II BA students wished to have a lab component, while the III BA students were not as particular about this aspect. Although almost all the students rated the various parameters at 4.20 and above, a slightly lower (3.90) rating was found in the electives offered. On the whole, the students felt that the curriculum was up-to-date and that it would prepare them for the future.

Alumni Feedback on Curriculum: The alumni feedback was most encouraging, with almost 96% marking the curriculum as excellent or very good. They felt that the curriculum endowed them with the necessary skills to take up higher studies and to prepare them for a career. It was suggested to provide more opportunities for internships since they had benefitted from internship training during their course.

Parents' Feedback on Curriculum: The parents (more than 85%) were satisfied with the curriculum as it is relevant to the current scenario. Nearly all the parents marked the parameters as Excellent, Very Good or Good. There were no negative remarks. No parent had marked the parameters as Poor. The ambience of the college, the rate of outcome, rate of the courses in terms of their relevance to the latest technology were highly appreciated, being mostly marked as Excellent. The parents were happy with the syllabus, quality of the courses included in each semester, allocation of the credits and evaluation. Most had marked the treatment of the students by the teaching faculty as Good or Very Good. All the parents expressed their confidence in the quality of the curriculum in helping secure good jobs or higher education opportunities for their wards.

Faculty Feedback on Curriculum: Almost all the faculty members (90%) felt that the curriculum development was progressing excellently, with the advice of the subject experts and those from the industry. Some suggestions were made to further update the syllabus.


Employers Feedback on Curriculum: The employers were satisfied with the knowledge and skill level acquired by the students through their curriculum. They were especially appreciative of the soft skills and communicative proficiency of the students. They stated that the syllabus matched the industry requirements. A few suggested more interaction with experts and from the industry and field trips to further strengthen the students' employability skills to meet the challenges of the future.






Student's suggestions were recorded for improving the curriculum. 

Parent's Feedback on Curriculum



Alumni Feedback on Curriculum






