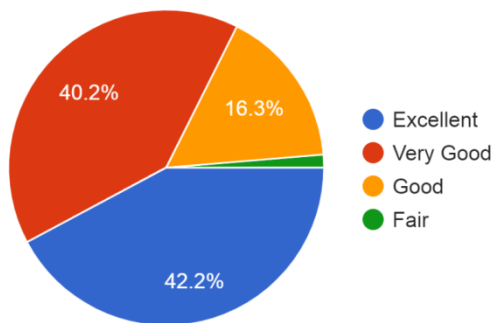

Curriculum

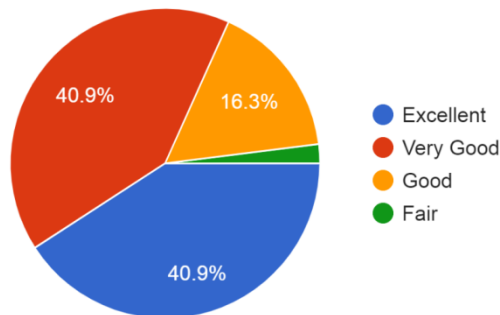
Curriculum Content and Strength of the syllabus is excellent and supple. The coverage of syllabus in the class is excellent 42.2% and 40.2% is very good. The fairness of evaluation system is about 81.8%. All the answer sheets getting verified individually. 65.8% of students say that the teachers regularly discuss about your

assignments in the class. Institution encourages the students to participate in internship, students exchange and field visits with 47.7% of votes.

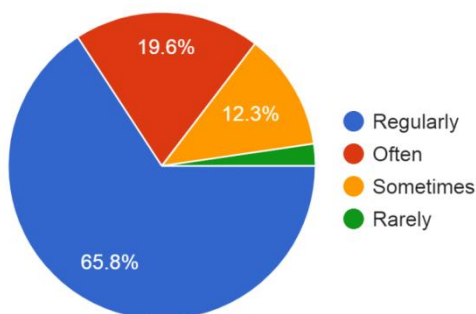
Quality of curriculum



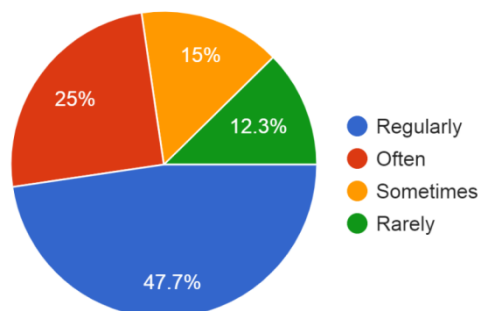
Fairness of evaluation



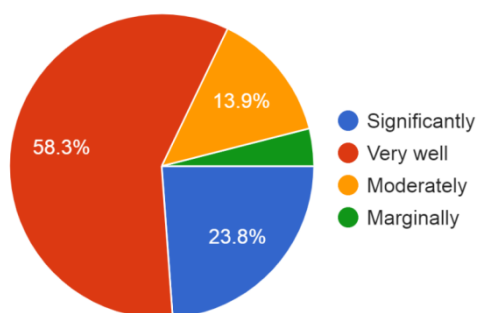
Discussion on Class room



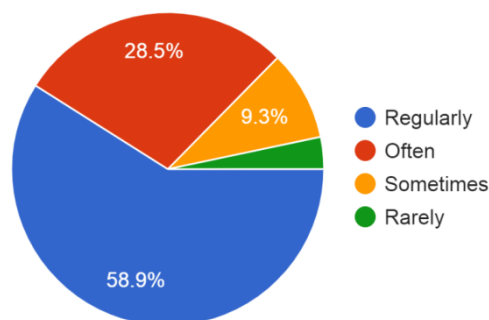

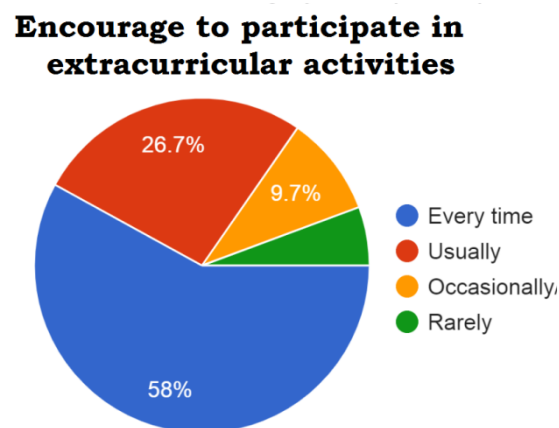
Followup Progress

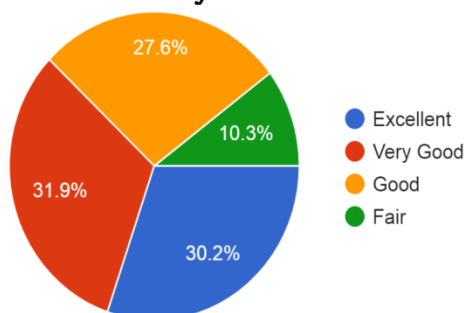
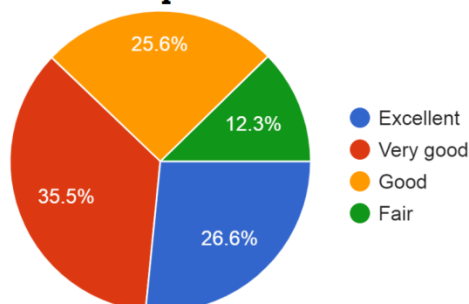
Extra and Co-curricular activities



58% of students reported that they are highly satisfied with the institution encourages to participate in Co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

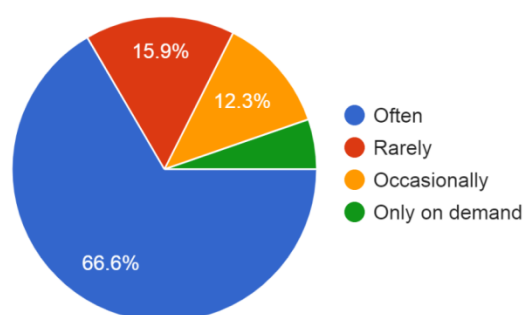
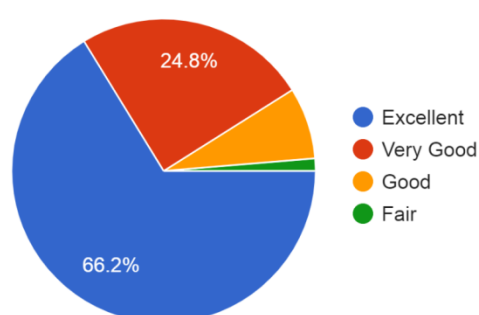
Placement Cell

Infrastructure

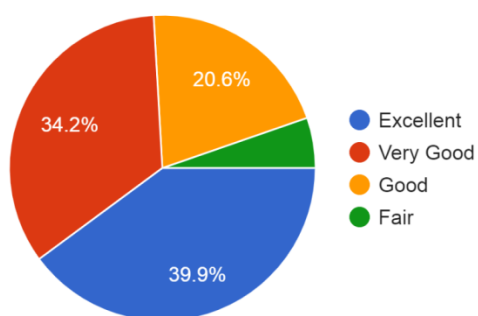

Usage of lab equipments**Resources available in library**

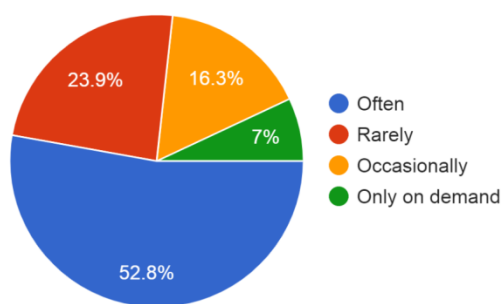
LCS/LL/Web facilities

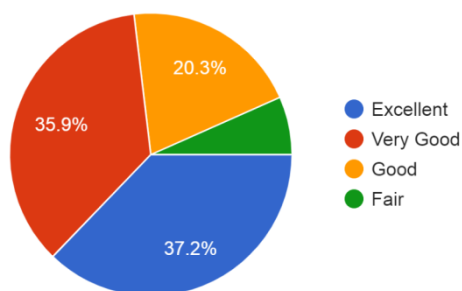
e-Resources available in website
