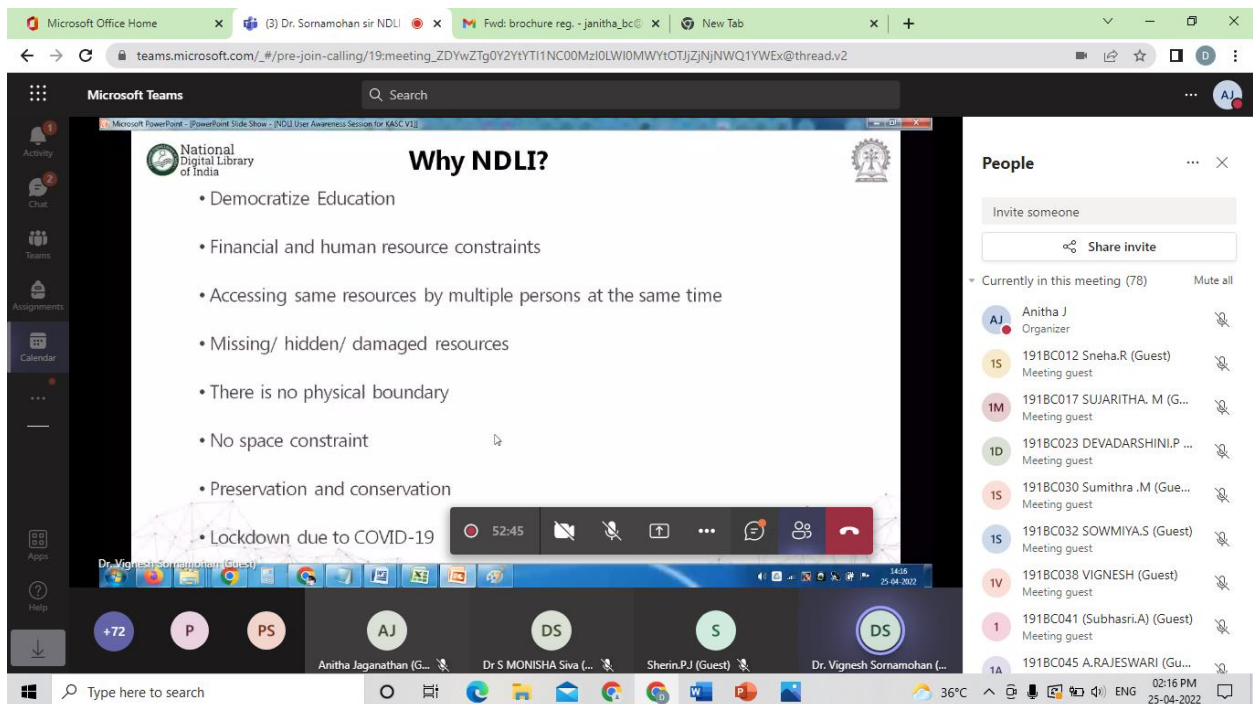

- Threat hunting – Cyber threat hunting is a proactive security search through networks, endpoints, and datasets to hunt malicious, suspicious, or risky activities that have evaded detection by existing tools.
- Types of hunting – Structured and Unstructured.
 - Structured - Structured hunting. A structured hunt is based on the IoA and tactics, techniques and procedures (TTPs) of an attacker.
 - Unstructured - An unstructured hunt is initiated based on a trigger.
- YARA and its rules - YARA rules classify and identify malware samples by creating descriptions of malware families based on textual or binary patterns. We can use Yara rules to define text or binary patterns that will match a file or component of a file to quickly find malicious files
- YARA is Open source tool and he shows the how to install the YARA.

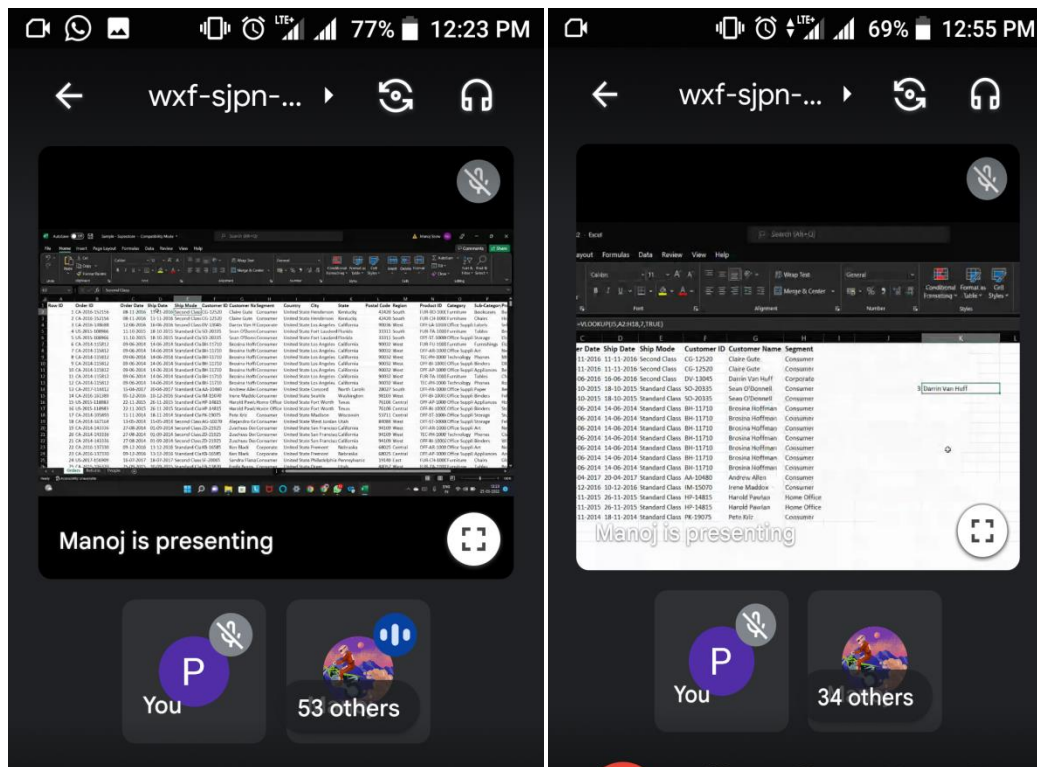

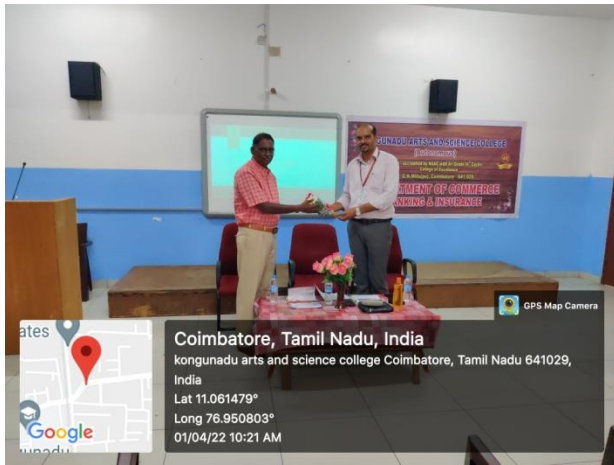
23.12.2021
