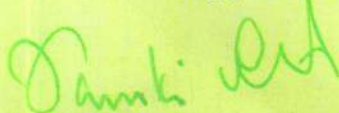


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Second Party

NOW THEREFORE THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER

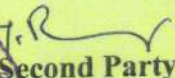
1. The Programme for which this MoU is signed is to be known as "**VALUE ADDED COURSES; ADD ON COURSES**" hereinafter referred as *Courses (course details are in the schedule)*; for the students of First Party hereinafter referred as *Trainees*.
2. Whereas the second party is desirous of undertaking a joint project for the training and handholding component of the said Scheme with the First party, both the parties consent by this Memorandum of Understanding, with the intention of being legally bound, accept the following terms and conditions:
3. **Terms and Conditions**
 - a. The Second party is the Resource Person for the above cited courses, they will provide adequate man power for the same.
 - b. The First party will source its students & allow its premises, infrastructure, establishment, appurtenant & etc., for smooth conduct of the above courses.
4. **Responsibilities of the First Party**
 - a) Provide the following minimum infrastructural facilities:
 - i. Computers with necessary softwares;
 - ii. Laboratories with Air Conditioners;
 - iii. Printers and photocopiers, as required;
 - iv. LCD Projectors/Display Screens/Speakers/Amplifiers & Mike;
 - v. Rooms for conduct of counseling;
 - vi. Necessary furniture & Electrical fittings for lighting;
 - vii. Use of generator in case of need;
 - viii. Vehicles parking facilities for trainees & trainers;

- b) Not make any financial commitment on behalf of the Second Party, nor shall take loans or create any other financial liability binding Second Party under this MoU;
- c) Provide Promotional activity and assistance for smooth conduct of the above courses, field visits & etc.;
- d) Realize all the fee from the trainees in any form whatsoever;
- e) Incur expenditure on all operations/services towards the above courses;
- f) The fee for the courses is to be decided on course to course basis, which is to be collected from the trainees and remitted to the Second Party, subject to the deduction of applicable TDS & provide the respective certificate thereon;

5. Responsibilities of the Second Party:

- a) Not make any financial commitment on behalf of the First Party, nor shall take loans or create any other financial liability binding First Party under this MOU;
- b) Develop and provide broad courses outline & Source material for the courses ;
- c) Provide adequate man power & printed materials towards smooth conduction of the Courses;
- d) Provide norms and guidelines wherever & whenever it is necessary towards the courses;
- e) Provide timely clarifications regarding training inputs and any other necessary information to the First Party;
- f) Shall ensure through proper co-ordination and consultation that all the trainers provide quality training to the trainees;
- g) Issue of Joint certificates (*signed by both the parties*) for the successful trainees;
- h) Keep a track of the number of trainees attending the programmes at each batch and deliver the same to the First Party after its completion.

6. Force Majeure

In the event of non-fulfillment of the contract terms and conditions due to any reason of force majeure namely fires, wars, riots, strikes, natural calamities, etc., neither the First Party nor the Second Party shall be held responsible for any loss or consequential loss.

7. Indemnity

The Second Party shall not, however, be liable for:

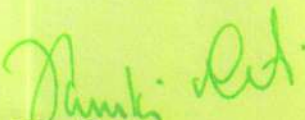
- a. Any payments of claims by employees of the First Party.

9. Breach of MoU

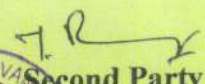
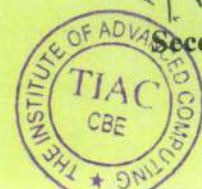
