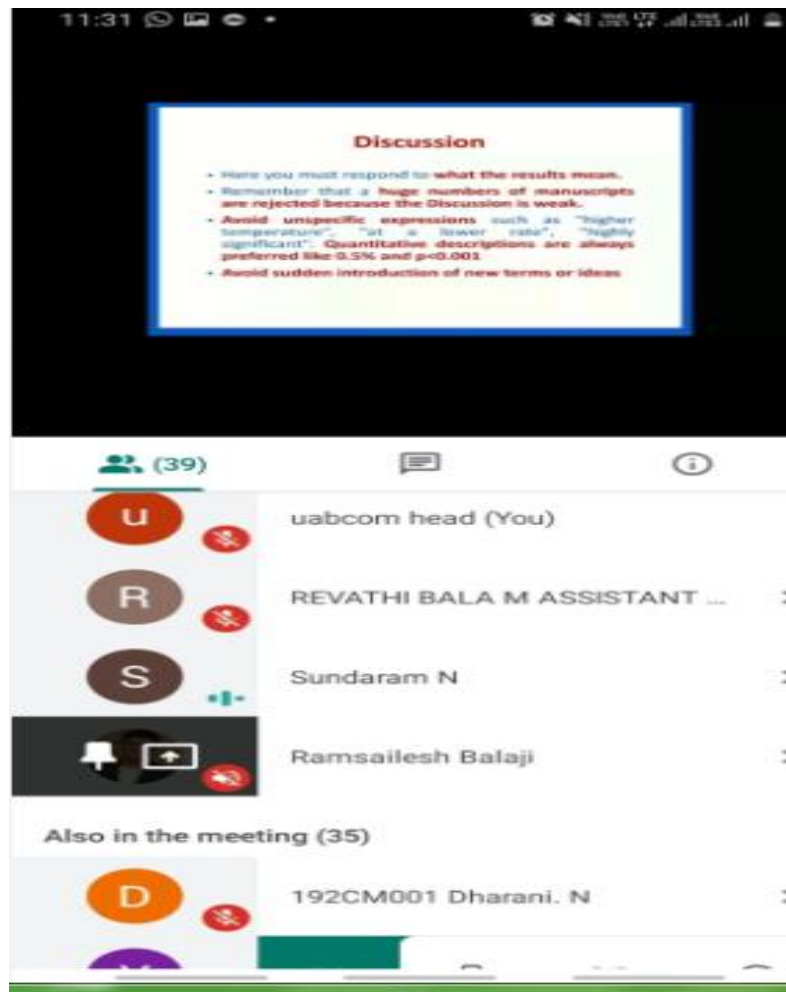
Department of Commerce with Professional Accounting

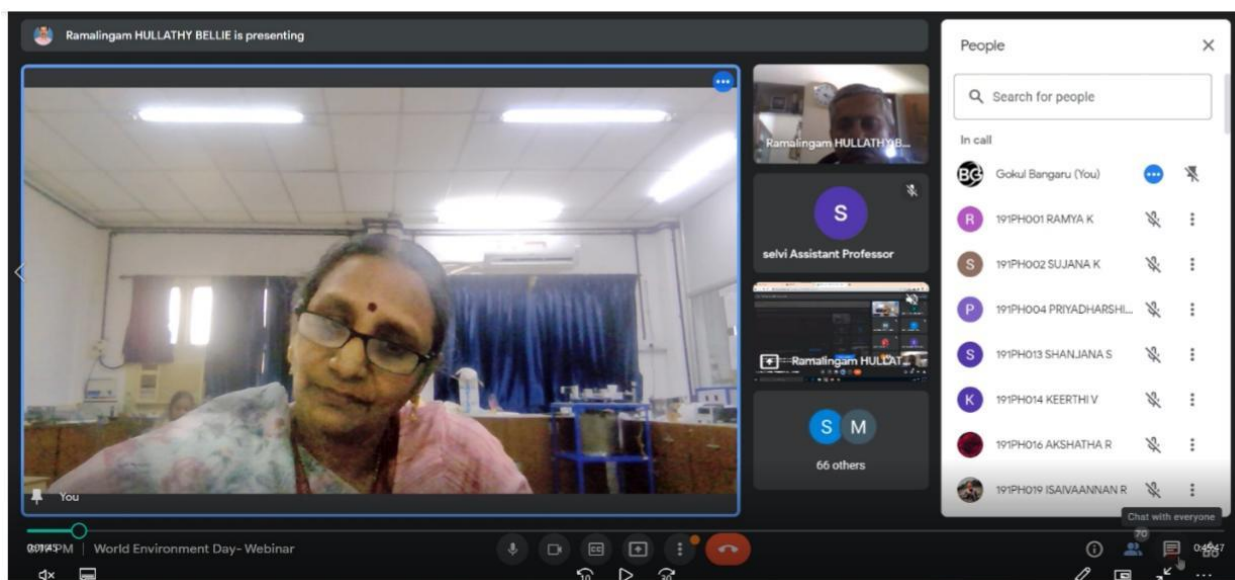

Report of Webinar on “Sanitation and Hygiene” on the occasion of World environment day, 2022

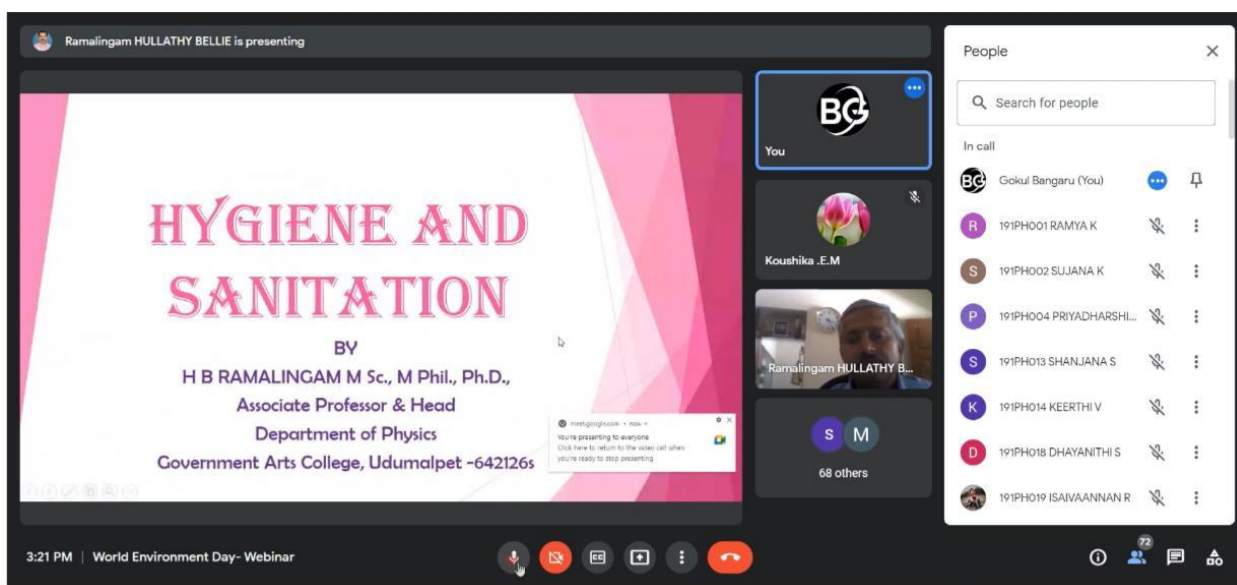
