This session was organized to focus on encouraging young minds to take in the idea of saleable farm commodity, involving market structure of system, and prototyping a social innovation through the involvement of local community and communication. **The** program was initiated and welcomed by Dr. S. R. Madhan Shankar, Dean Academics, President IIC, Head PG Department of Biotechnology, Kongunadu Arts and Science College and guest introduced by Dr.B.Vishnupriya, Assistant Professor, IIC member, Department of Biotechnology, KASC.

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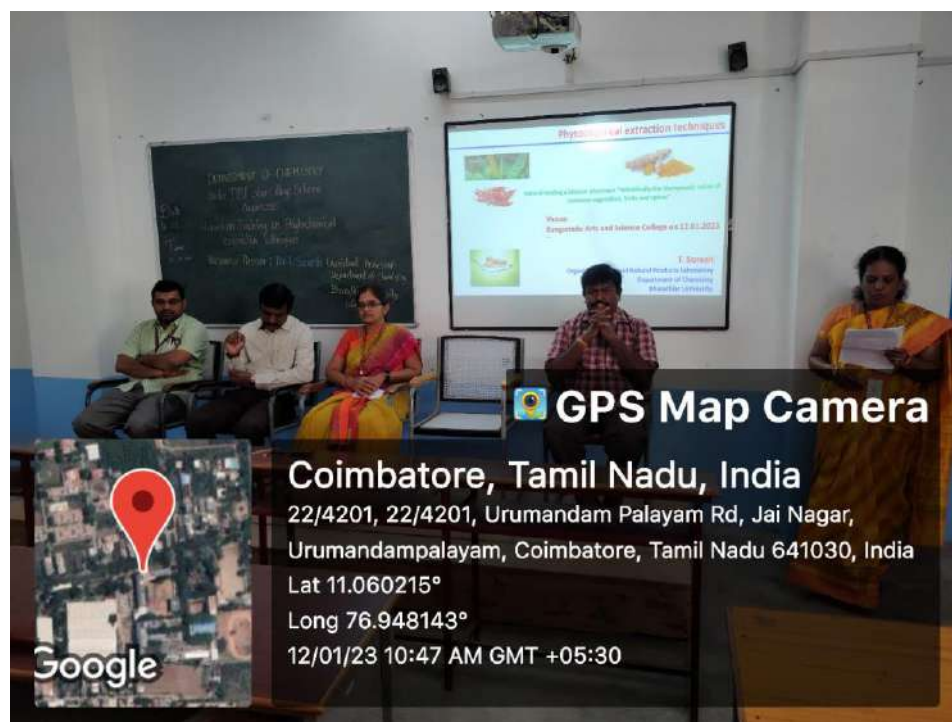
2. Hands on Training on Phytochemical extraction techniques

Soxhlet extraction is a continuous process of extraction with a hot organic solvent. Typically, Soxhlet extraction is used when the desired compound has a limited solubility in a solvent, and the impurity is insoluble in that solvent. He explained the assembly, working procedure, advantage and disadvantage of the Soxhlet extraction method. He also explained chromatographic techniques such as thin layer chromatography and column chromatography. He demonstrated thin layer and column techniques in laboratory. 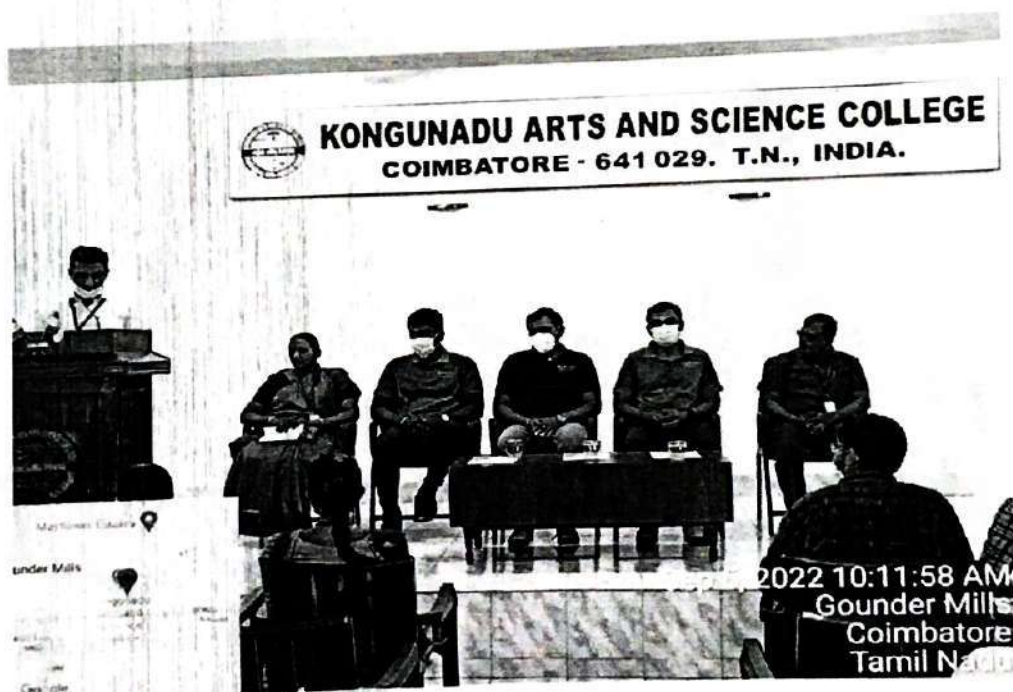

Report of the Programme

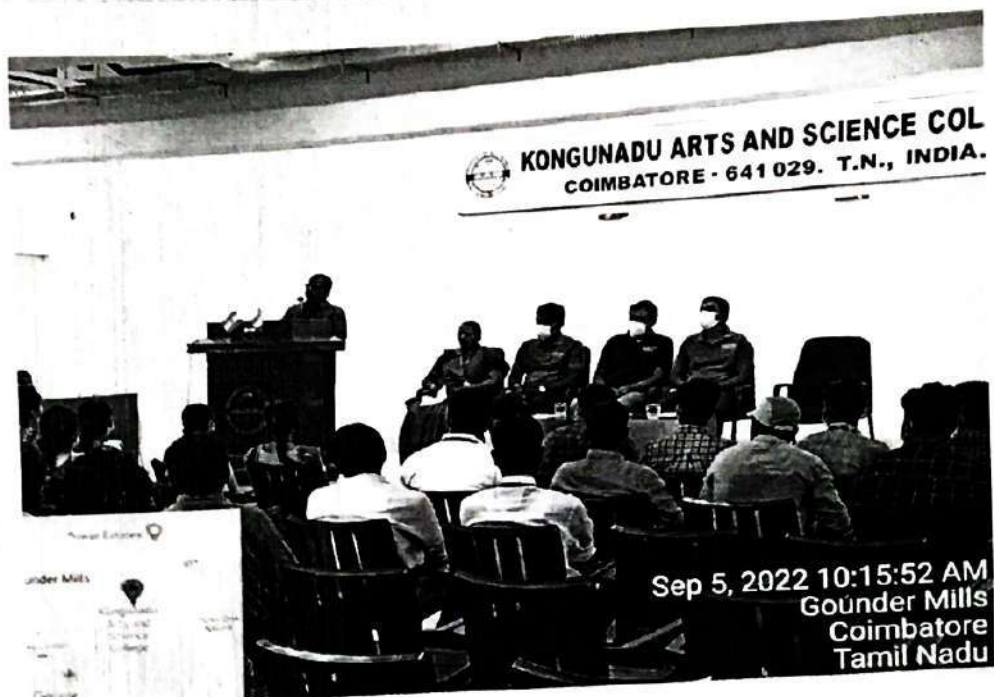

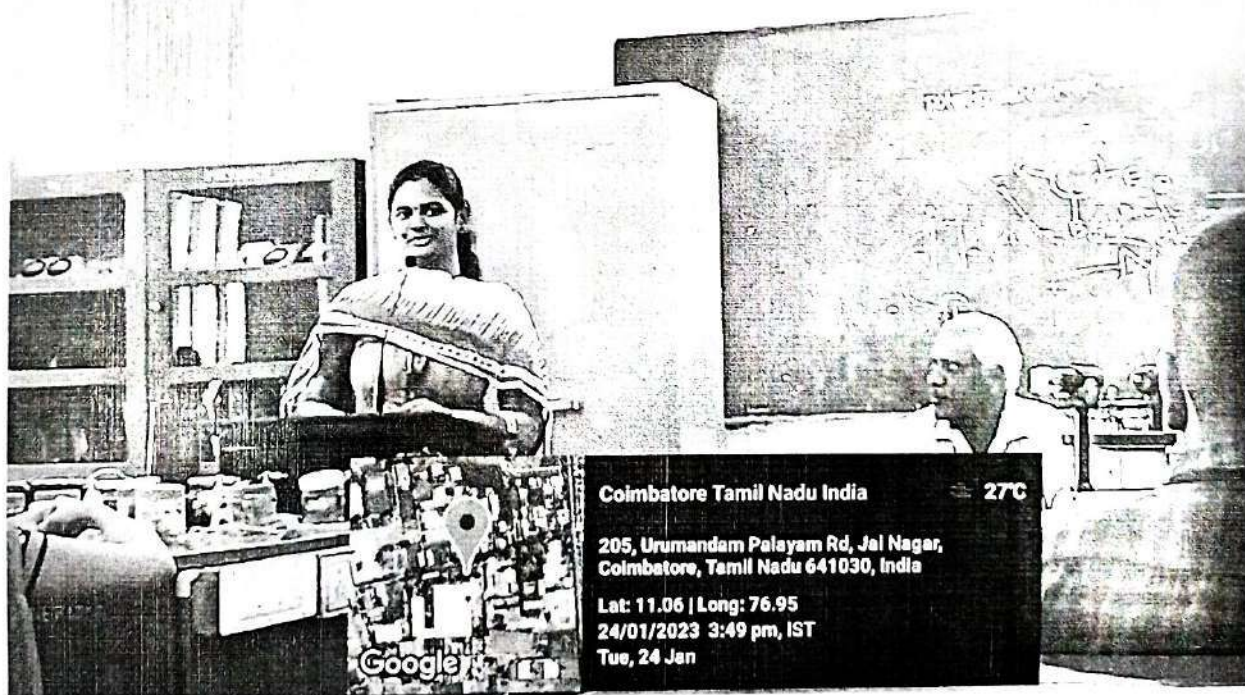

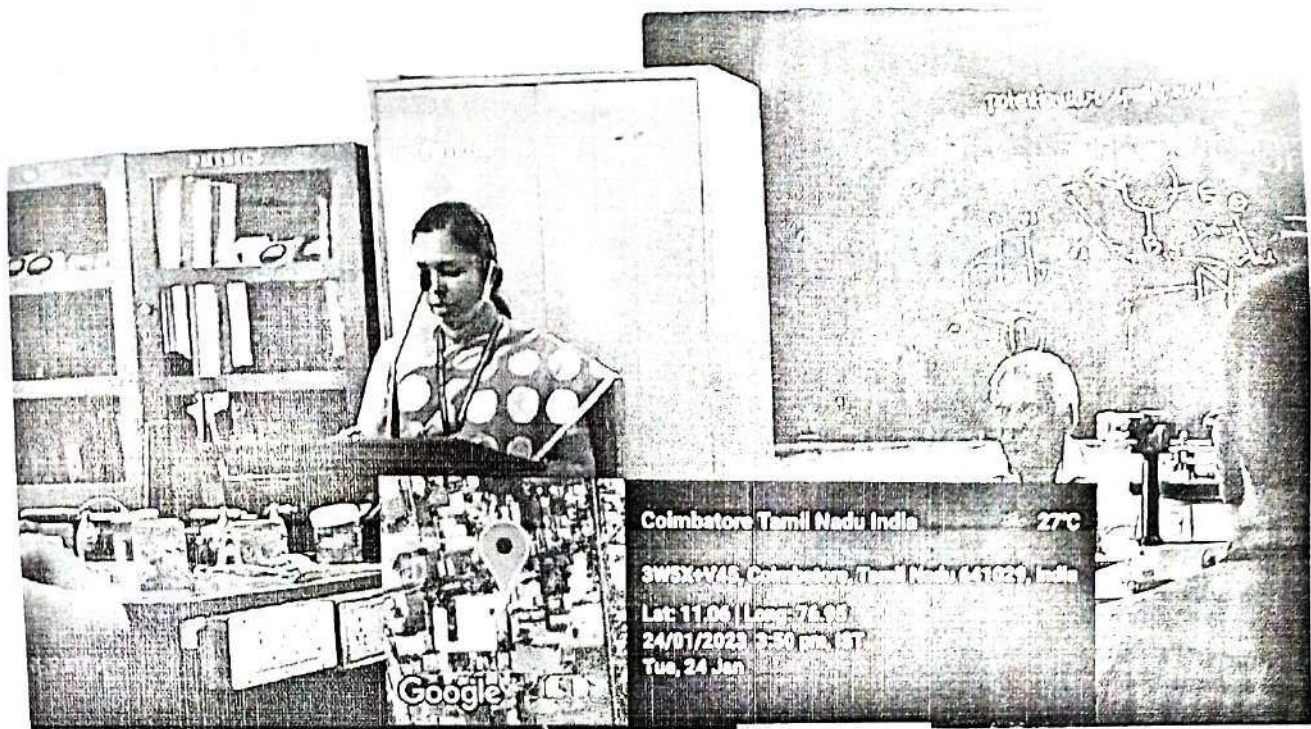

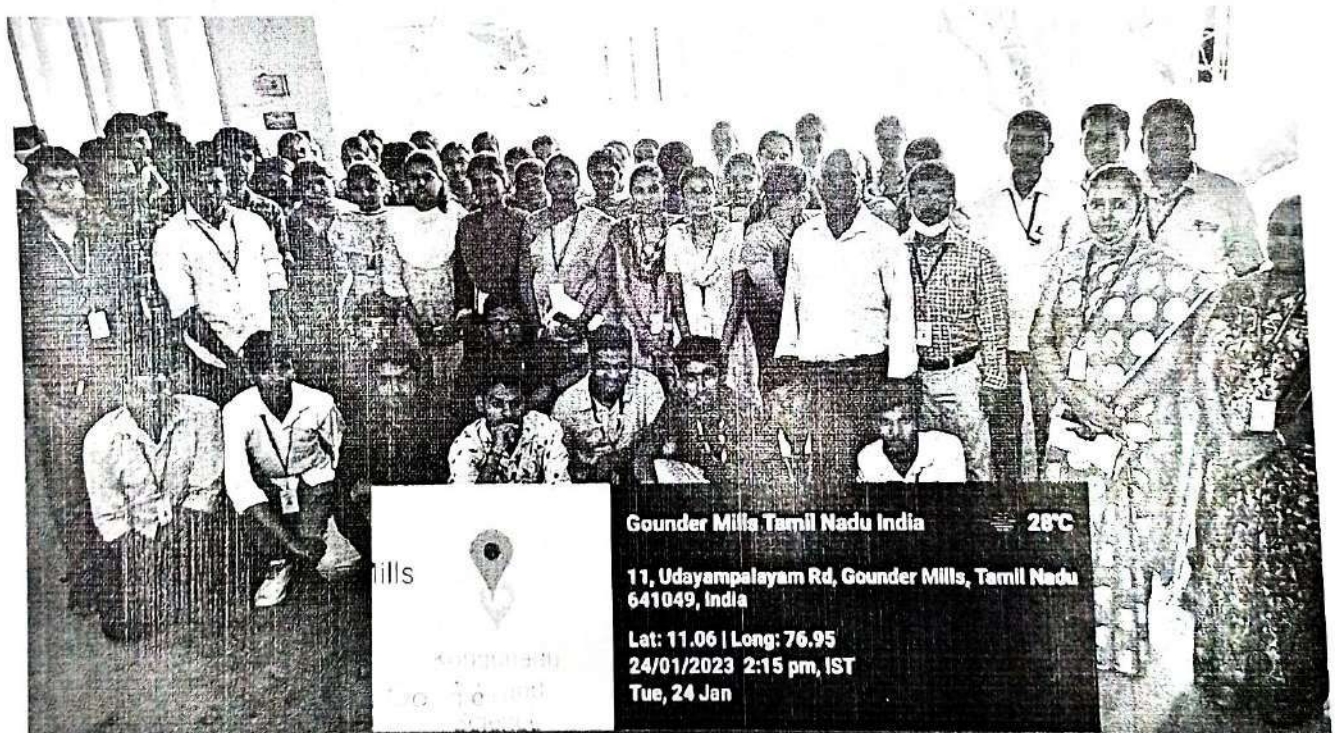
