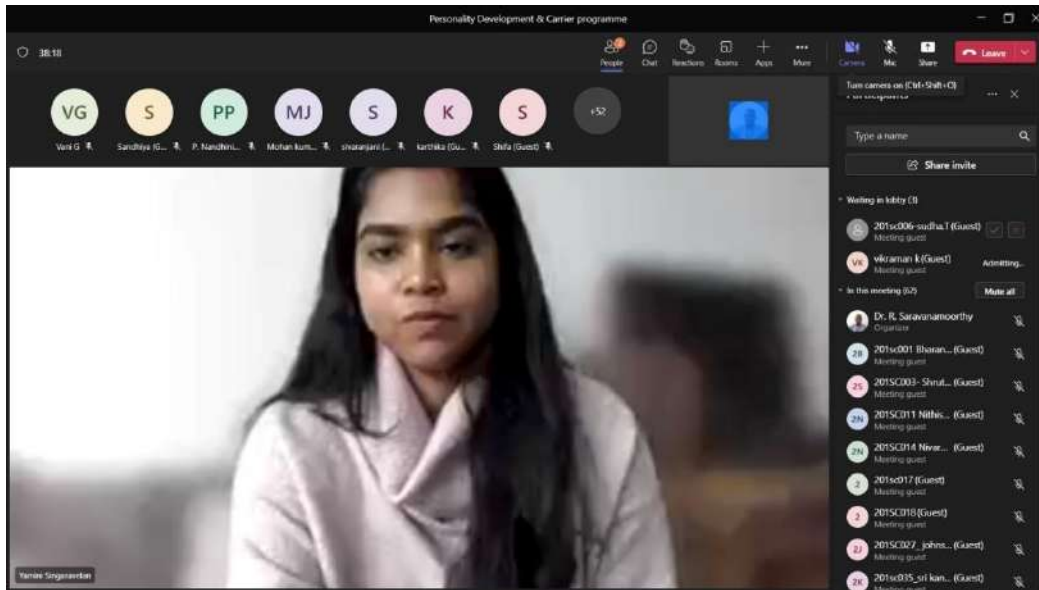

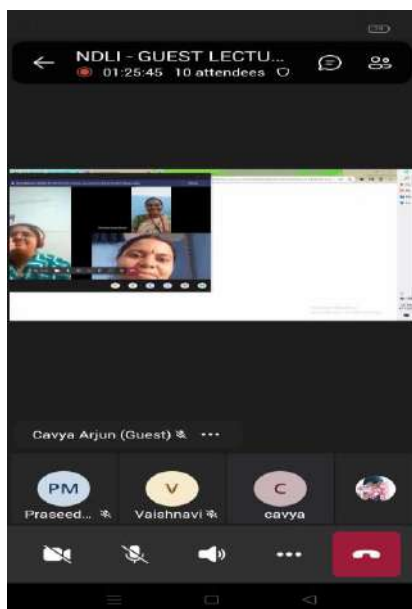
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REPORT

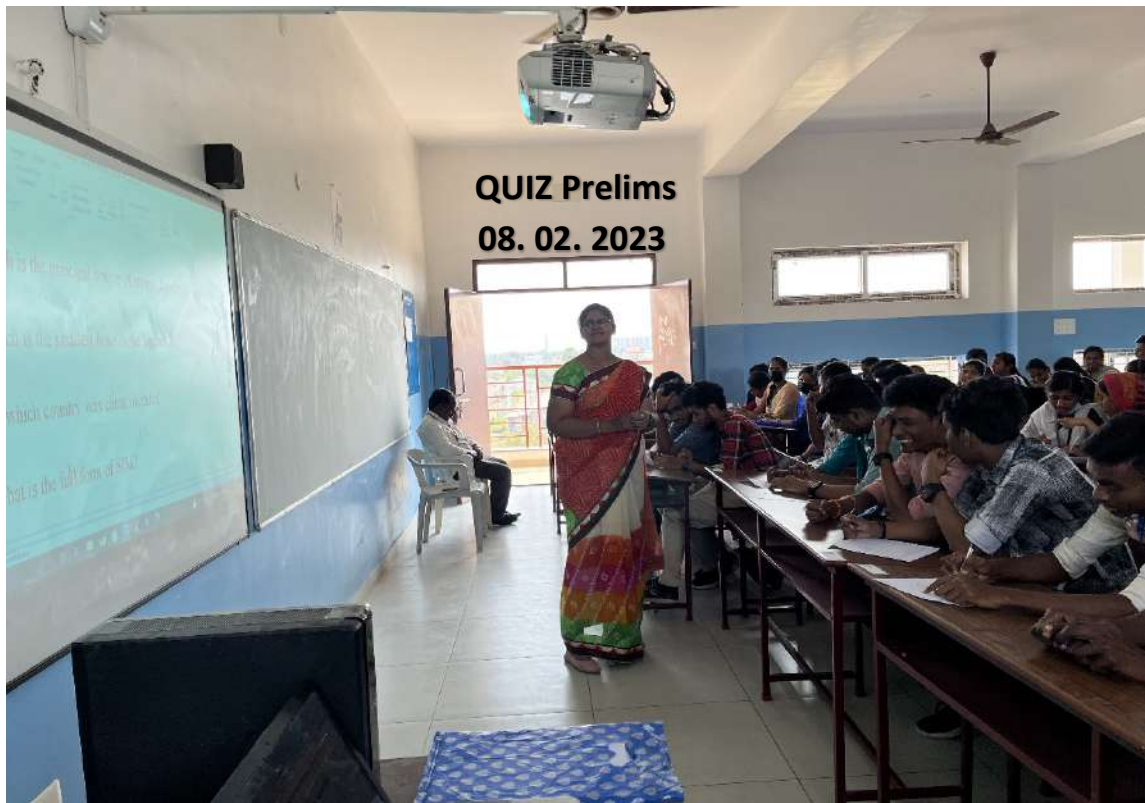
Report on College Day Quiz Competition

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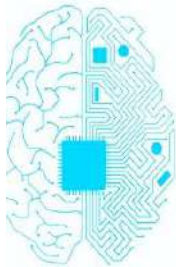

நம் நாட்டின் சிறுதானியங்களில் மிகவும் பழைமையானது தினை. கிட்டத்தட்ட 10,000 ஆண்டுகளாக கிழக்கு ஆசியாவில் பயிரிடப்பட்டு வந்த தானியம். இதன் உற்பத்தியில் இந்தியாவுக்கே முதல் இடம். தானியங்களில் சிறுவிதைகளைக் கொண்ட கம்பு, வரகு, சாமை, தினை, குதிரைவாலி, கேழ்வரகு, சோளம், கொள்ளு போன்றவையே சிறுதானியங்கள். மிகக் குறுகிய காலத்தில், சாதாரண மண்ணில், வறட்சி நேரத்திலும் வளரக்கூடியவை. இவற்றில் புரதம், நார்ச்சத்து, கால்சியம், இரும்புச்சத்து, வைட்டமின்கள் போன்ற ஊட்டச்சத்துகள் அதிக அளவில் உள்ளன. எளிதில் ஜீரணமாகக்கூடிய தன்மைகொண்டவை; மனிதர்களைப் பாதிக்கும் பல நோய்களிலிருந்து பாதுகாக்கும் ஆற்றல் கொண்டவை.

சாமை - சாமையில் அரிசியைவிடப் பலமடங்கு நார்ச்சத்து உள்ளதால், சர்க்கரை நோயாளிகளுக்கு உகந்தது. மற்ற சிறுதானியங்களைவிட சாமையில் இரும்புச்சத்து அதிகம். இது, ரத்தசோகையை நீக்க உதவும். மலச்சிக்கலைப் போக்கும். வயிறு தொடர்பான பிரச்சனைகளுக்கு நல்ல தீர்வைத் தரும்.

கேழ்வரகு / ராகி - அரிசி, கோதுமையைவிட கேழ்வரகில் ஊட்டச்சத்துகள் அதிகம். குறிப்பாக சுண்ணாம்புச்சத்து, இரும்புச்சத்து, பாஸ்பரஸ், நார்ச்சத்து, வைட்டமின் பி அதிக அளவில் உள்ளன. இதனால் எலும்புத் தேய்மானம், ரத்தசோகை, இதய நோய், மலச்சிக்கல், சர்க்கரைநோய் போன்றவற்றால் பாதிக்கப்பட்டோருக்கு சிறந்தது. குழந்தைகளுக்கு நல்ல ஆரோக்கியத்தைத் தரும். ராகியைக் களியாகச் செய்து சாப்பிட்டால், உடல் உஷ்ணம் நீங்கும்; உடல் வலிமை பெறும்.

குதிரைவாலி - ஊட்டச்சத்துக்கள் நிறைந்த, சுவை மிகுந்த குதிரைவாலி, சர்க்கரைநோயைக் கட்டுப்படுத்த உதவக்கூடியது. இதில் உள்ள நார்ச்சத்து, புற்றுநோய், உயர் ரத்த அழுத்தம், இதய நோய்களைத் தவிர்க்க உதவும். செல்களைப் பாதுகாக்கும் ஆன்டிஆக்ஸிடன்ட் ஆகச் செயல்படும் தன்மை இதற்கு உண்டு.

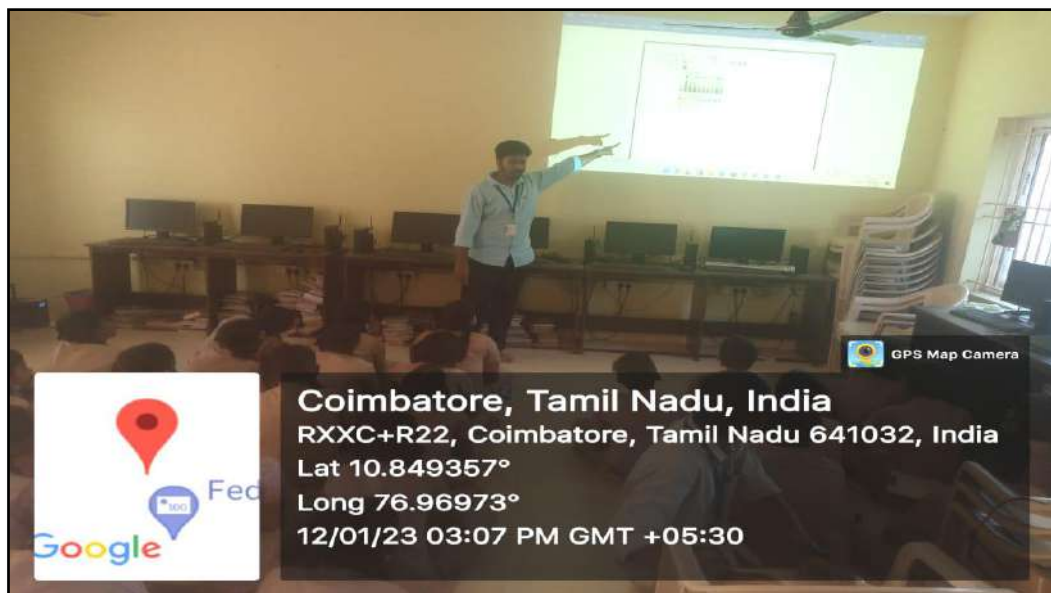
Computer Literacy Programme for Adapted Village School Students

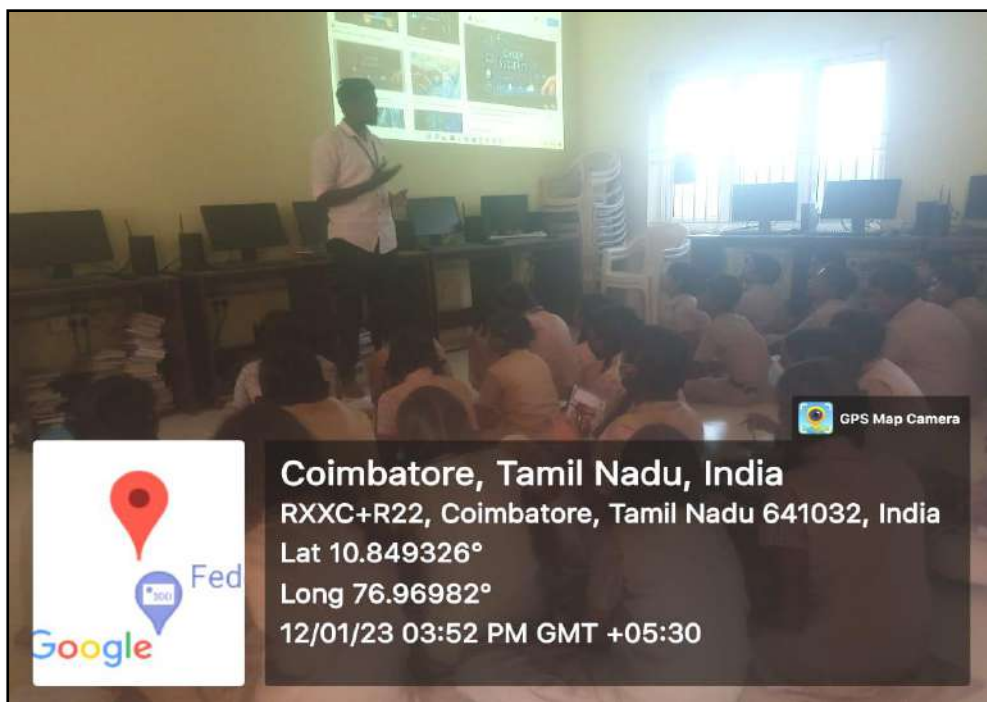
