It is my privilege to present the Annual Report of our prestigious institution before this distinguished gathering.

The college reopened for II and III year UG and II year PG Programme on 18th July 2022 and classes for the first year UG Programme on 1st August 2022 and I Year PG Programme on 12th September 2022.

I am proud to state that our College offers 25 UG, 13 PG, 18 certificate programmes, 7 Diploma programmes, 5 PG Diploma programmes and 13 Research programmes. During the current academic year, 3287 students are studying in UG programmes and 506 students in PG programmes. 226 Ph.D and 63 M.Phil scholars are pursuing research degrees in various disciplines. Out of 4082 students, 1844 are women students and it is 45% of the total student strength. This stands as a testimony to the yeomen services rendered by this college towards women literacy. With immense pleasure I state that our college has a distinction of having 154 PhDs and 37 M.Phils. Degree holders, among the total number of 215 teaching faculty.

KASC-TECH HUB was constituted for recruiting students of our College. The Students are trained through TECH HUB and they are working for real time projects.

DBT - STAR COLLEGE SCHEME:

Under DBT- STAR College scheme our institution has been approved and sanctioned the proposal for total outlay of Rs 82 lakhs and Rs 40 lakhs of non-recurring fund has been released and utilized for purchasing the equipments. First Year release of Recurring grant of Rs 14 Lakhs has been released with more focus on the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Computer Science.

DST- FIST:

The first phase of prestigious DST FIST fund 2022-2023 under Level 0 PG colleges Category(SF Stream- PG Chemistry, PG Biochemistry, PG Computer Science) to strengthen research facilities has been sanctioned. The total amount is 1.5 Crore for the period of 5 years. First Instalment of amount Rs. 21.5 lakhs has been sanctioned by DST-FIST to equip XRay Diffractometer (XRD).
