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## **I. INTRODUCTION**

Kongunadu Arts and Science College (Autonomous) has conducted a six day Student Induction Programme (SIP) for the first year undergraduate students. The main objective of this programme is to acclimatize the students to the college environment and to make them familiar with the college culture. ### III. EVENTS

Student Induction Programme-2022 was started with invocation followed by welcome address by Dr.R.Thirugnanasampandan, SIP Coordinator and Dr. M. Lekeshmanaswamy, Principal offered the felicitation.

#### Talk on Human Values

Swami Bhaktiviratananda, Ramakrishna Mission Vidyalaya, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu highlighted in his inaugural address that education is the manifestation which holds the truth and the truth is god. Swami Bhaktiviratananda insisted, young students are pillars of future India so students should have moral and ethical values and be ferocious and active like a lion to the betterment of society. Swami Ji clearly explained that there is no place called ideal place so make your surrounding environment as ideal to work and serve the nation. Subsequently Swami Bhaktiviratananda advised the students that; smartness, money and designation are not enough for successful life so do not take unpleasant truth anywhere and follow Swami Vivekananda's words, Believe in yourself because you are creator of your own destiny. Swami Ji also cautioned that social media sometimes will create wrong impression on young minds so break the negative impressions by smart way and use the opportunities to develop the nation.





## Talk on drug abuse

Mr. K Murali Krishnan, District Tobacco Control Cell, Deputy Director of Health Services, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu and Dr. M. Saranyadevi, District consultant from the Office of Deputy Director of Health services delivered a talk on drug abuse.

The session focused on the increasing rate of addiction towards tobacco and tobacco related products in our society, especially among the school and college students. The speakers highlighted on the adverse effects of all kinds of tobacco products by clearly explaining about the materials which are used for producing those products which are very harmful for the vital organs of our system. On enunciating the ill effects of smoking, the students were advised about spoiling not only their own lungs and organs but also the innocent people around them when they are smoking. Overall session focused on motivating and advising students to completely avoid using tobacco and related products to lead a sound and healthy life for now and ever. At the end of meeting, everyone was made to take a pledge to say not to use tobacco in any ways for their healthy life and surroundings.





## Introduction of Club activities

Club activities like co-curricular, extracurricular, student welfare center and other activities like entrepreneurial development cell (EDC), institution innovation cell (IIC), KASC- Tech Hub and i-Hub etc were introduced to the students by the respective coordinators and they explained the mechanism of functioning, roles and responsibilities, achievements, social services etc. In addition, Google form has been created by respective club coordinator and circulated to the students for easy enrolment to the respective club.



## Entrepreneurship Skill Development

Mr. M. Sathyanarayanan, Deputy Director Laghu Udyog Bharathi, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu delivered a talk on entrepreneurship skill development

In his inaugural address he stated that today's younger generation is very good in being smart, technologically updated and exploring nature. Mr. M. Sathyanarayanan briefed his entrepreneurial journey starting with employee to employer. He advised the students to learn everything, do not neglect to learn, explore and do not hesitate to travel. He also explained about Atmanirbhar Bharat scheme-how it reduced import of toys from ₹.14000 crore to ₹11000 crore. Subsequently, an young entrepreneur Mr. Arun's Start up - Craft Casary Pvt.Ltd, Coimbatore was introduced and he shared his experiences how to become an entrepreneur and also explained about digital marketing strategies to sell his products with minimum human resource. Students eagerly interacted with resource persons and clarified their doubts about entrepreneurship.





## Talk on Placement Opportunities

Dr.J. Vijayalakshmi, Placement Director, Kongunadu Arts and Science College spoke about placement opportunities. She explained how to improve communication skill as it's a very essential qualification for appearing any form of interview. Placement Director also advised the students to improve group discussion ability and keyboarding skills. She also highlighted that resume should be prepared and updated frequently and also to equip for aptitude test. Further, Placement Director explained how a placements cell is functioning, its responsibilities, on campus and off campus interviews, companies and packages etc. Finally guidance was given for the students about how to prepare for the final year placements.



## Talk on Cyber Security

Dr. L. Kathirvelkumaran, ICT Academy, Kongunadu Arts and Science College, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu was the resource person and discussed about cyber security, attacks and safety measures.

In his speech he gave a clear idea about how to secure our electronic gadgets like mobile phones, computer and lap top etc. He also insisted the students that it's difficult to secure the data unless we are aware about data cyber-attacks. He mentioned that precautionary measures are always to be followed for example once the work is completed using internet we should turn off internet connection, frequent change of passwords for email, internet bank accounts etc. are to be strictly followed. He demonstrated how to learn techniques to protect e-mails and to block digital advertisements, security techniques for digital money transactions, types of banks scams and its techniques, ATM skimmer machine, fake websites and identifying methods. Finally, he summed up the role of cybercrime cell and its functions.





## Afternoon activities

### Familiarization with Department

Students of all the departments were familiarized with the respective heads of the departments, staff, mentors and nonteaching staff. Teaching and nonteaching staff members introduced themselves to the students. The Heads of the departments explained about the details like year of introducing the programme, student strength, programme outcome and programme specific outcome, core papers, allied, elective and skill based subjects, internal and external mark distribution systems, college timing, discipline and dress code etc. In addition, strength and achievements made by the department, notable alumni were also discussed.



## Creative Arts and Culture Activity

On second day of SIP, afternoon session on creative arts and culture session was conducted by each department. Students were asked to express their interest towards arts and culture. They were asked to present their creative work in the form drawing on the topic of need of the hour like water conservation, alternate energy sources etc. Students took active participation and enumerated their interest in creative arts and culture. Students were also asked to share their gratitude towards people who supported them.



## Literary activity

As a part of literary activity, first year students of each department were taught the benefits of National Digital Library of India (NDLI). Students were guided step by step to login NDLI link to refer the subject content on the spot itself and also guided the students to create an account in NDLI. Further, students were encouraged to download e-books of various other disciplines of science and technology, literature and also the availability of video lectures, audio books, research repositories, question papers etc. In addition, students were taken to the library and guided to search and find books of their interest.





## Lab Tour

The lab tour was arranged for making the students familiar with the labs available in their department and they were explained about the functions and troubleshooting of various instruments. In addition, students were taken to common instrumentation centre and computer labs for knowing advanced instruments and softwares. Awareness on the lecture capturing system facility and smart classroom facilities were explained to the students and how it helps them in their studies. Further students were instructed with basic laboratory safety practices and standard operating procedures. In addition, students were also taken to medicinal plant garden, green house and mushroom cultivation unit.



## Physical Activity

Physical activities like field events, sports, yoga, meditation and traditional arts were introduced to the students by physical education department and special teachers. Students were suggested to engage themselves and regularize physical activities for maintaining sound health and fitness and also encouraged to participate in various sports events. The importance of homemade food and healthy living habits were explained and suggested to stay physically fit.



#### **IV. FEEDBACK SESSION**

Student feedback about SIP was collected from 1200 students. The programme came to an end by the vote of thanks by SIP Coordinator Dr.R.Thirugnanasampandan, Assistant Professor of Botany.
