The parents were equally satisfied with the curriculum which the Department updates periodically. The majority of the parents were happy with the teaching-learning atmosphere in the department.



PARENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM





FACULTY FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

EMPLOYERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM






Parents' Feedback on Curriculum:


