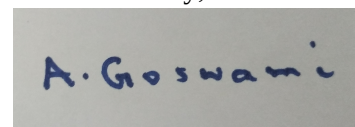
As per rule 211 of GFR, the accounts of project shall be open for inspection by sanctioning authority/audit whenever the institute is called upon to do so.
