Detail Descriptions of Event:

The NSS Units (IV and V) of Kongunadu Arts and Science College, in collaboration with Alert NGO, organized a three-day workshop on First Aid – VOICE (Volunteers In Case of Emergency) from 19th July 2023 to 21st July 2023. The event commenced with a prayer song, setting a positive and solemn tone for the proceedings. Dr. L. Kathirvelkumaran, NSS Programme Officer, extended a warm welcome to the participants, and Dr. M. Lekshmanaswamy, the Principal, offered felicitations.

A special talk on "CPR Training" was delivered by V. Karthik, Principal Trainer from ALERT NGO. Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) was emphasized as a life-saving technique crucial in emergencies such as cardiac arrest, heart attack, or accidental drowning, where an individual may face severe respiratory distress. Mr. Karthik elaborated on the significance of the "Golden Hours" and stressed the potential of CPR in saving lives during this critical period. He urged the students to actively promote awareness within the general public, encouraging them to respond effectively during emergencies. Following the talk, all NSS Volunteers engaged in a hands-on demonstration of CPR using a mannequin. This practical exercise aimed to ensure that participants gained practical knowledge and proficiency in the life-saving technique. The key takeaway message emphasized during the workshop was "Each one to be trained in a family," underlining the importance of extending this knowledge to broader community circles.

Around 50 NSS students actively participated in the program, gaining valuable insights and awareness about CPR, which undoubtedly contributed to their overall benefit. Dr. R. Sarvanamoorthy, the Academic Coordinator, expressed gratitude and concluded the event by proposing a vote of thanks. 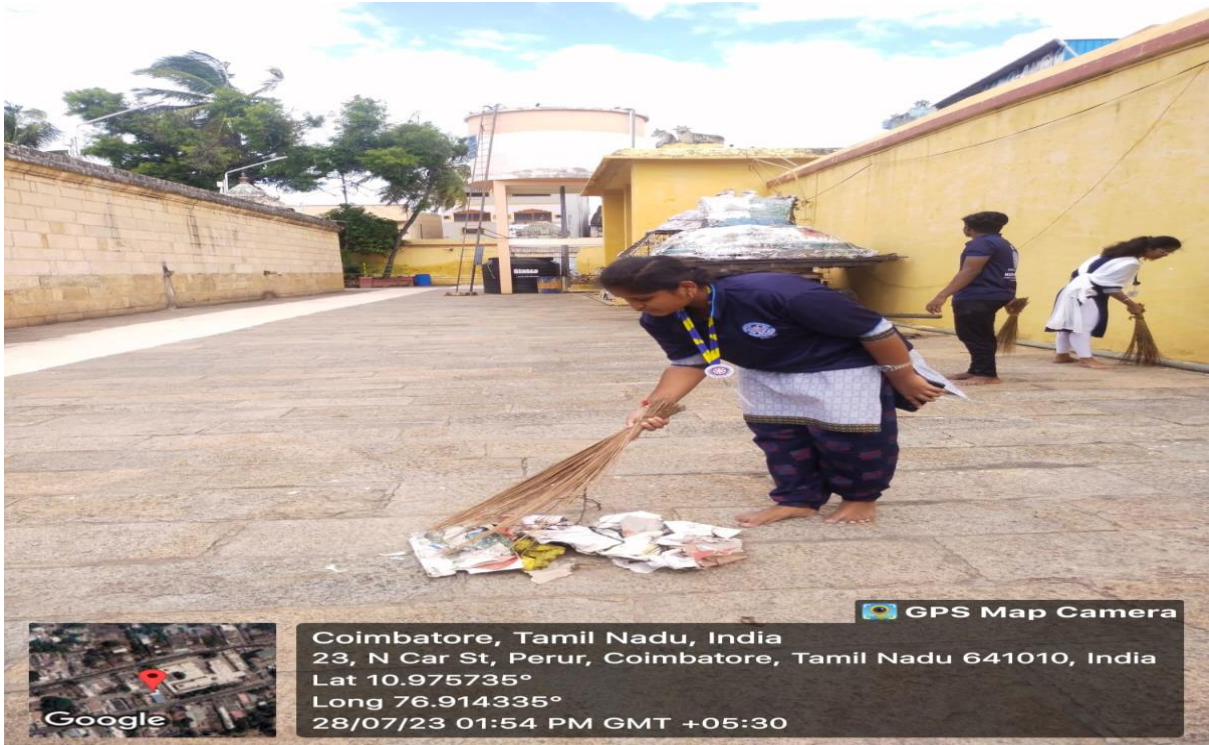
