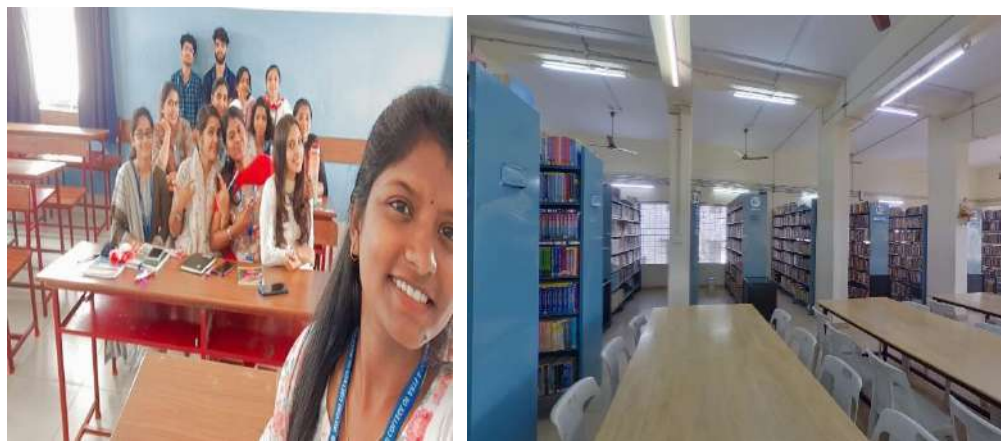
Student cum Faculty Exchange Programme from 11.9.2023 to 15.9.2023.

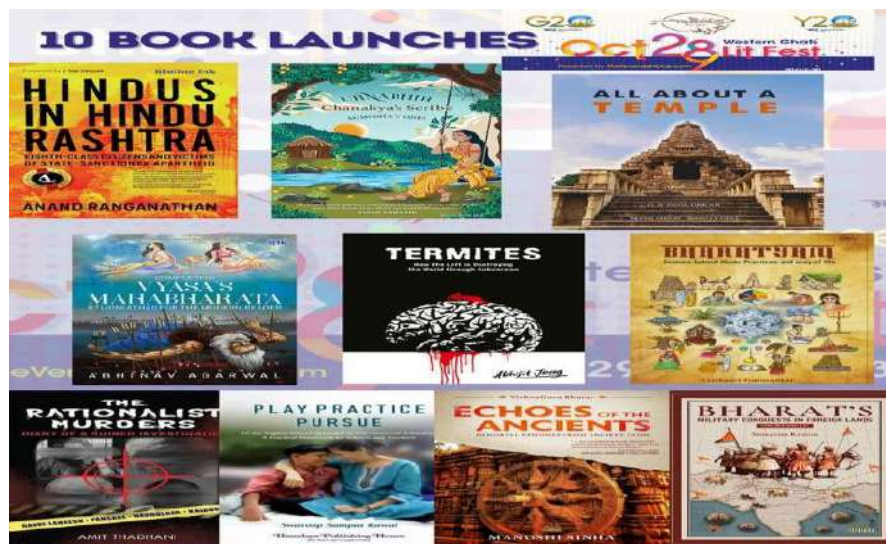


Report on Lit Fest and Book launch

Report on Self-Defence Workshop

“The counselling and self-defence workshop” was held on [7th, 8th, 10th & 11th August-2023] Venue Sister Nivedita Hall at Department of Psychology Kongunadu Arts and Science College. The workshop started with prayer song which is sung by the 1st & 2nd year psychology students and Mrs. Kavitha, Head of the Department, Department of Psychology was given by the welcome address to the chief guest and other department staff, students. Then chief guest introduction was given by the Ms. Vasuki, Assistant Professor Department of Psychology.

The workshop conducted for various departments first year female students and around 456 students were participated in this workshop. The workshop aimed to empower participants with a holistic approach to personal well-being and essential self-defence skills, enhance their personal safety awareness, the risk of abuse and cybercrime, mental and physical resilience, and boost their confidence in handling potential threats. Provide guidance on how to protect themselves in the digital world, and impart basic self-defence skills for personal safety. The Primary objective of the workshop is to raise awareness about different forms of abuse, including physical emotional and online abuse. To educate participants about common cyber threats, such as identity theft, online harassment, and scams. To provide participants with strategies for managing stress, anxiety, and building emotional resilience. Teach basic self-defence techniques. Educate participants about personal safety, awareness, and risk assessment. Educated the student’s basic self-defence techniques enhance their physical confidence and personal safety.

The "counselling and self-defence workshop" took place on [7, 8, 10, and 11 August 2023] at the Psychology Department of Kongunadu Arts and Science College in Sister Nivedita Hall. Around 456 individuals attended the session that was held for first-year female students in several departments. The goal of the session was to provide attendees with a holistic approach to personal well-being and fundamental self-defence skills, improve their knowledge of personal safety, the risk of abuse and cybercrime, mental and physical resilience, and build their confidence in addressing potential threats. Give advice on how to stay safe online and have an impact on fundamental self-defence techniques for personal safety. The workshop's main goal is to increase public awareness of many types of abuse, including cyber, emotional, and physical abuse.



The Workshop began with opening remarks from (7th August-2023) that welcomed the participants and emphasized the importance of recognizing and addressing abuse. The counsellor Anu Kiruthika Manager from Aram Foundation Charitable Trust, she was provided information on different forms of abuse, their signs, and the importance of seeking help when facing abusive situations. The Anu Kiruthika provides an overview of common cyber threats, including identity theft, online harassment, and financial scams. Participants received practical tips and advice on how to protect themselves online, secure their personal information, and recognize phishing attempts.

The participants engaged in interactive discussion, sharing their experiences and concerns related to abuse. The counsellor provides guidance and resources for those in need.

Basic self-defence Techniques

The Mr.J.Gokul Raj, Founder Trustee, Martial Arts Trainer, Aram Foundation Charitable Trust. He was taught fundamental self-defence techniques, including proper stance and balance, Strikes (e.g., Punches, Kicks), Escapes from common holds, Defence against verbal harassment. The Mr. J Gokul Raj Self-Defence instructors provide live demonstrations of self-defence techniques, allowing participants to observe and learn and participants were then given the opportunity to practice these techniques with partners, ensuring they understood and could apply what they had learned. Simulated scenarios were conducted to test participants' ability to respond to potential threats. These scenarios included situations such as being approached by a stranger or dealing with verbal aggression. Finally we conclude the self-defence workshop on 11th August 2023.

He elaborated on the wide-ranging effects of chronic stress on mental and physical health. He discussed how stress can lead to anxiety, depression, automatic negative thoughts, and lack of attention, concentration, and decision-making. He emphasized the importance of recognizing the signs and symptoms of stress in oneself and others, as early intervention can prevent more severe consequences. Emphasized that behavioural addiction is real and can be as challenging to overcome as various behavioural addictions. He encouraged self-awareness and reflection on addictive behaviours, as recognition is the first step toward recovery.



Speaker was introduced to a variety of stress management techniques, both cognitive and behavioural, that can be implemented in daily life. These include mindfulness meditation, deep breathing exercises, and progressive muscle relaxation. He stressed the significance of regular physical activity, a balanced diet, and adequate sleep as fundamental components of managing stress effectively. Students learned about common triggers for behavioural addiction, such as stress, loneliness, boredom, and negative emotions. He highlighted the importance of identifying personal triggers to develop effective coping strategies. He discussed evidence-based treatment

approaches for behavioural addiction, including Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and contingency management. The students were informed about the benefits of support groups and counselling in providing guidance and accountability during recovery.
